




Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook National Hurricane Center Miami, Florida







Severe Weather Outlook Thursday, October 05, 2023







Longer-period swells associated with easterly winds blowing across the Gulf of Mexico are likely to cause wave run-up at the beaches. Minor flooding possible, as well as a High Risk of Rip Currents. Water may reach or perhaps push into the dunes at times along the barrier island. If caught in a Rip Current and unable to escape, face the shore and call or wave for help.







Keetch-Byram Drought Index


