




Flash Flood/Flood Potential Tuesday & Wednesday Two rounds of heavy rainfall Tuesday & Wednesday





Guidance continues to suggest the potential for two rounds of widespread, heavy rainfall. The first will continue into Tuesday, and the second will be Wednesday and Wednesday night. The Weather Prediction Center (WPC) has issued a slight risk of excessive rainfall, which could lead to localized flash flooding. Check back for updates!



Additional showers and storms are expected this afternoon, especially along and west of I-35. Severe weather is not expected, but a few rumbles of thunder may impact your outdoor plans. Bouts of brief heavy rain will lead to temporary ponding in poor drainage areas.




Isolated showers and thunderstorms will be possible over our western counties on Tuesday. Otherwise, expect partly cloudy skies and humid conditions.

A second round of rain is expected tonight into Wednesday as a line of storms is expected to push through. Widespread accumulations of at least a half inch of rain is expected with higher chances of very heavy rainfall found across the east-central Permian Basin.




Showers and thunderstorms will eastward from eastern New Mexico this evening and will then spread to the east across the South Plains, Rolling Plains, and extreme southern Panhandle. Heavy rainfall leading to flash flooding will be the main threat with these showers and storms, this threat being greatest to the east of a Childress to Brownfield line. In addition, the strongest thunderstorms may be capable of producing strong wind gusts to near 55 mph.






