

Showers and storms are expected today, particularly along and east of US-281. Locally heavy rainfall and flooding are possible, particularly along and east of the I-35 Corridor.



Scattered showers and thunderstorms are expected today. Locally heavy rainfall is the primary concern. Could not rule out localized flooding, especially in poor drainage areas.

Hazardous Weather



The bulk of the rain will be shifting into East Texas today, however, lingering showers will be possible as far west as the I-35 corridor. Average rainfall amounts will amount to about 2-3 inches. Afternoon high temperatures are expected to climb into the upper 70s to mid 80s.



Increasing moisture and daytime heating will produce scattered showers and thunderstorms today with very warm temperatures. Meanwhile, along the Lower Texas Coast, a slightly enhanced pressure gradient will produce Small Craft Exercise Caution conditions on the offshore Gulf waters.





Fire Danger Forecast




Burn Ban

Keetch-Byram Drought Index


