





A Freeze Warning is in effect across North Texas and parts of western Central Texas. Low temperatures late tonight and early Tuesday morning will fall to or below 32 degrees with areas of frost as well. Those not in the warning area will see more clouds with lows Tuesday morning in the mid to upper 30s. Make sure to protect any sensitive outdoor vegetation and outdoor plumbing or faucets in order to avoid damages do to the cold. Lastly, make sure livestock and outdoor pets are protected from the the abnormally cold temperatures expected. Temperatures will likely rise above freezing by 10 AM Tuesday.



Sub-freezing temperatures expected across portions of the ArkLaTex on Monday Night from Midnight through just after daybreak.

#### **Hazardous Weather**






A Winter Weather Advisory is currently in effect until early this afternoon for southeastern Culberson County, southwestern Reeves County, most of central and eastern Jeff Davis County, northern portions of Presidio and Brewster Counties, and all of Pecos County. Expect mixed precipitation with periods of freezing rain or freezing drizzle, with ice accumulations up to one tenth of an inch in the highest elevations. Plan on slippery road conditions, slow down and use caution when traveling, and allow extra time for travel.




