




Wind Speeds



## **Hazardous Weather**



A strong cold front will move through the area today. A few strong storms with gusty winds and small hail are possible in parts of Central and East Texas between 9 AM and 3 PM. It will turn breezy and much cooler behind the front with northwest winds of 20-25 mph and higher gusts.



Closely monitoring the threat of strong to severe storms Today as an Enhanced Risk is in place across much of the Four State Region. All hazards of severe weather are still being considered possible at this time. Be prepared when severe storm watches and warnings are issued.

#### **Hazardous Weather**




Showers and thunderstorms are expected today ahead of a cold front that will move through later this afternoon and evening. A few storms could become strong to severe late this afternoon through early evening.




Severe thunderstorms are expected today from east Texas through much of Louisiana. All modes of severe weather are expected, including large hail to the size of golf balls, damaging wind gusts up to 70 mph, and tornadoes. A few strong tornadoes will be possible for areas along and north of Highway 190.




