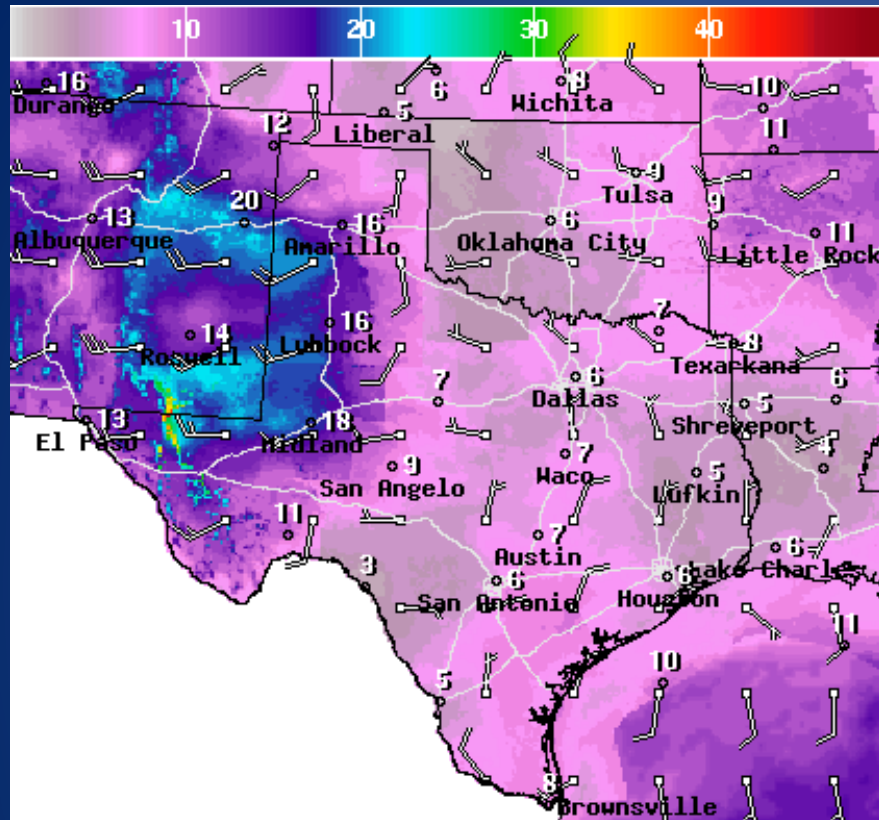

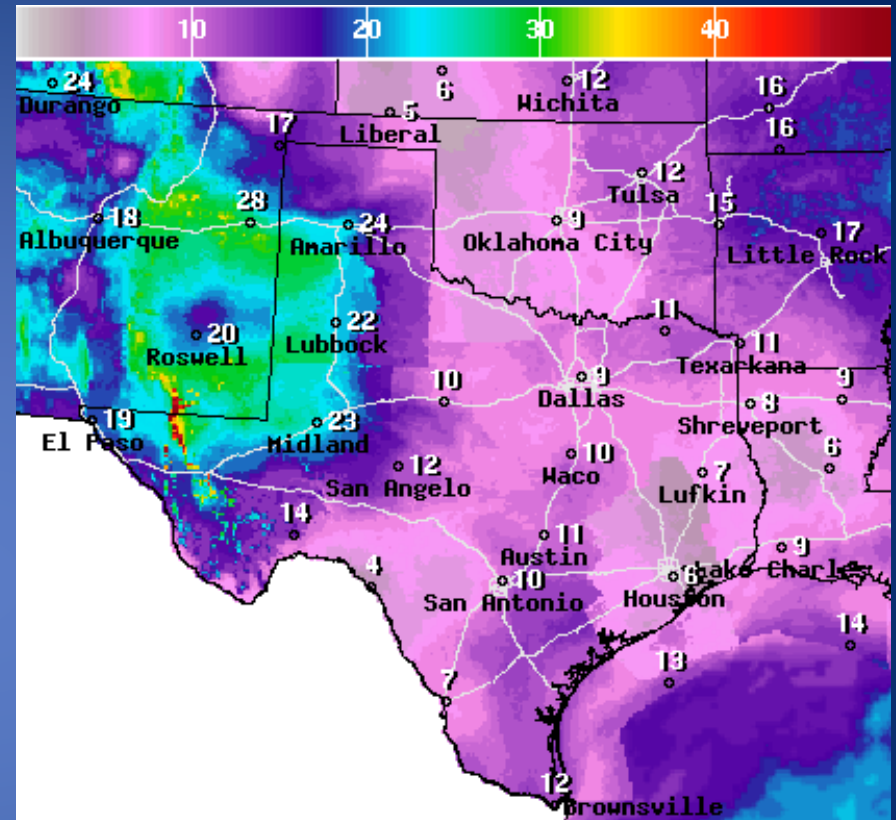

Wind Speeds



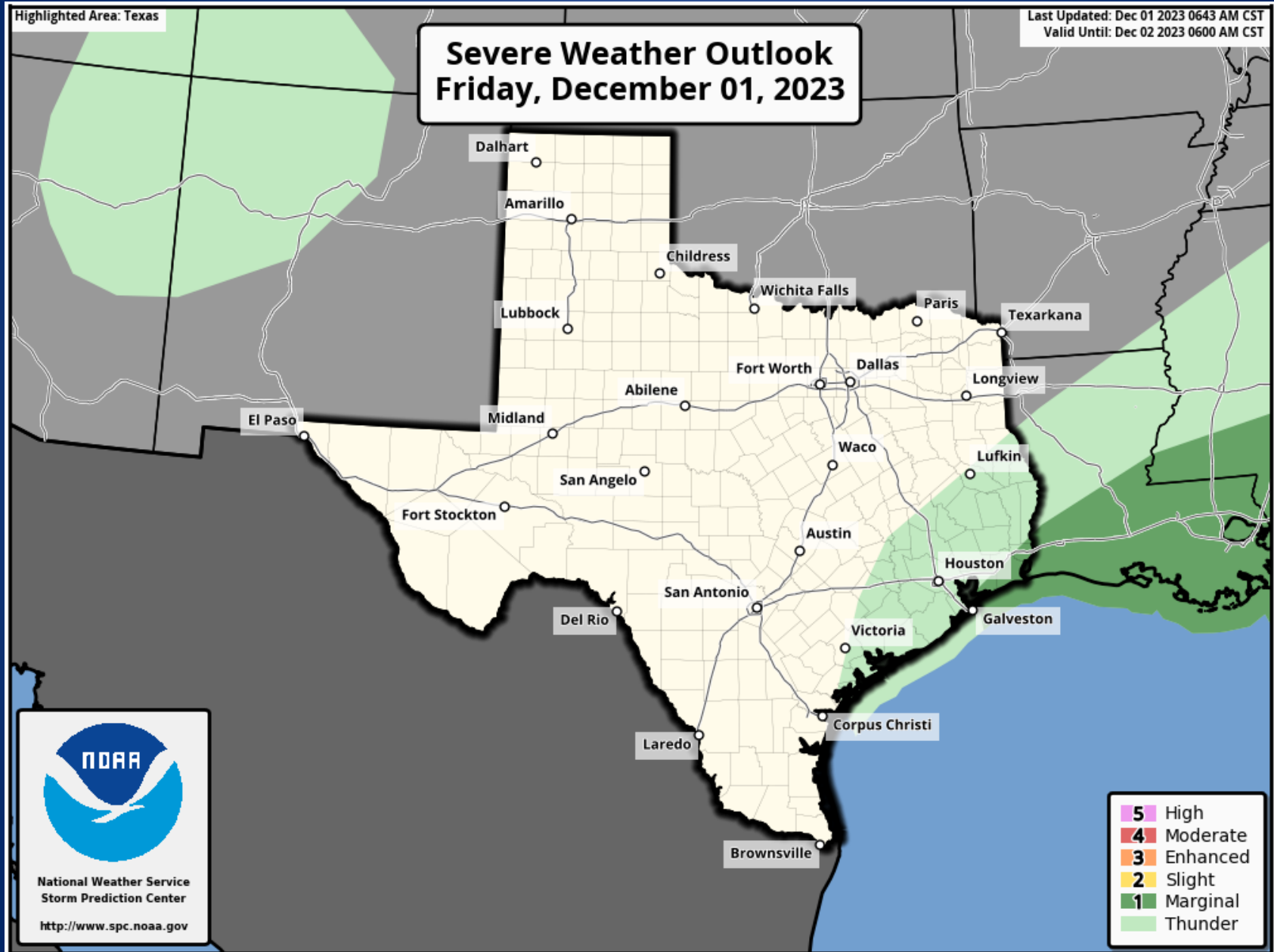

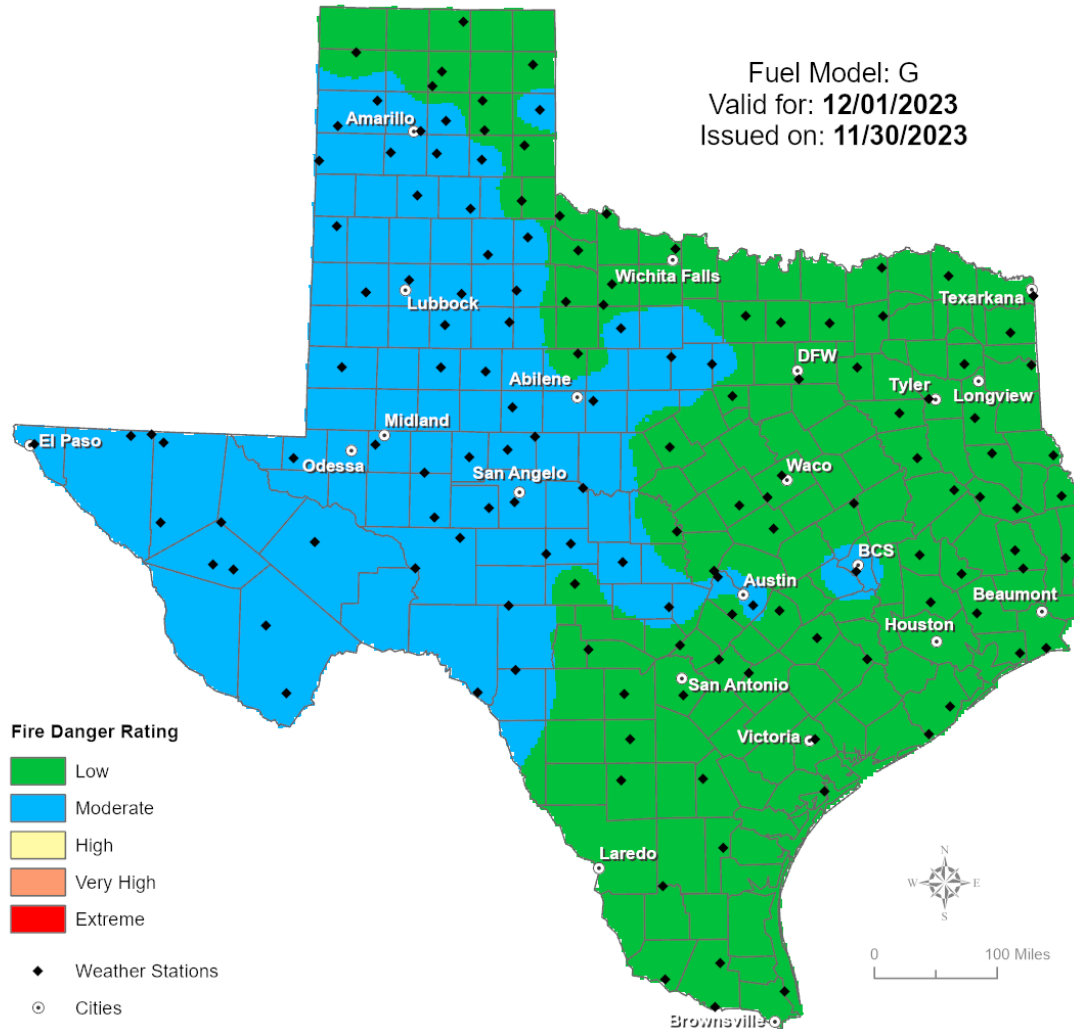

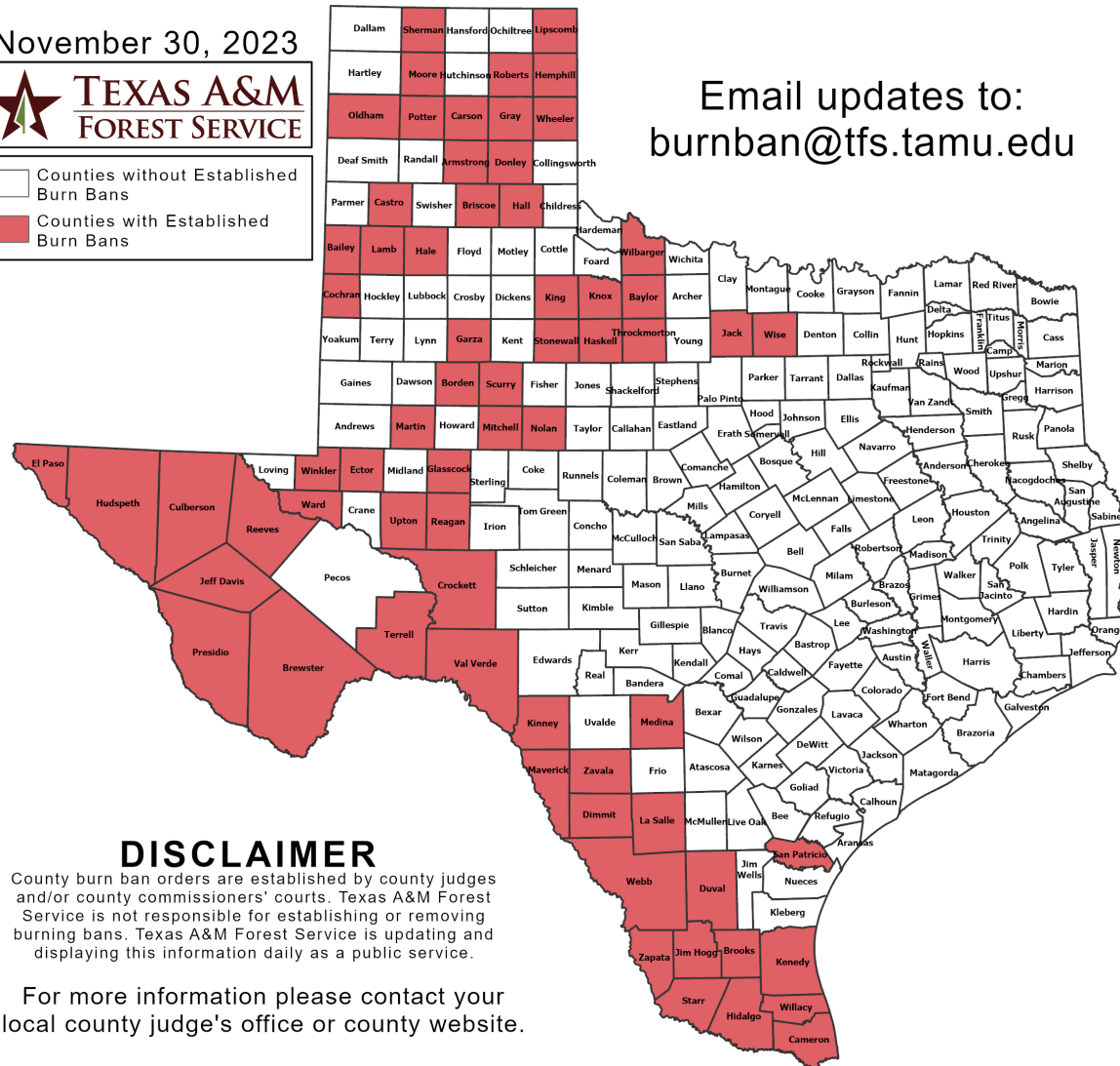

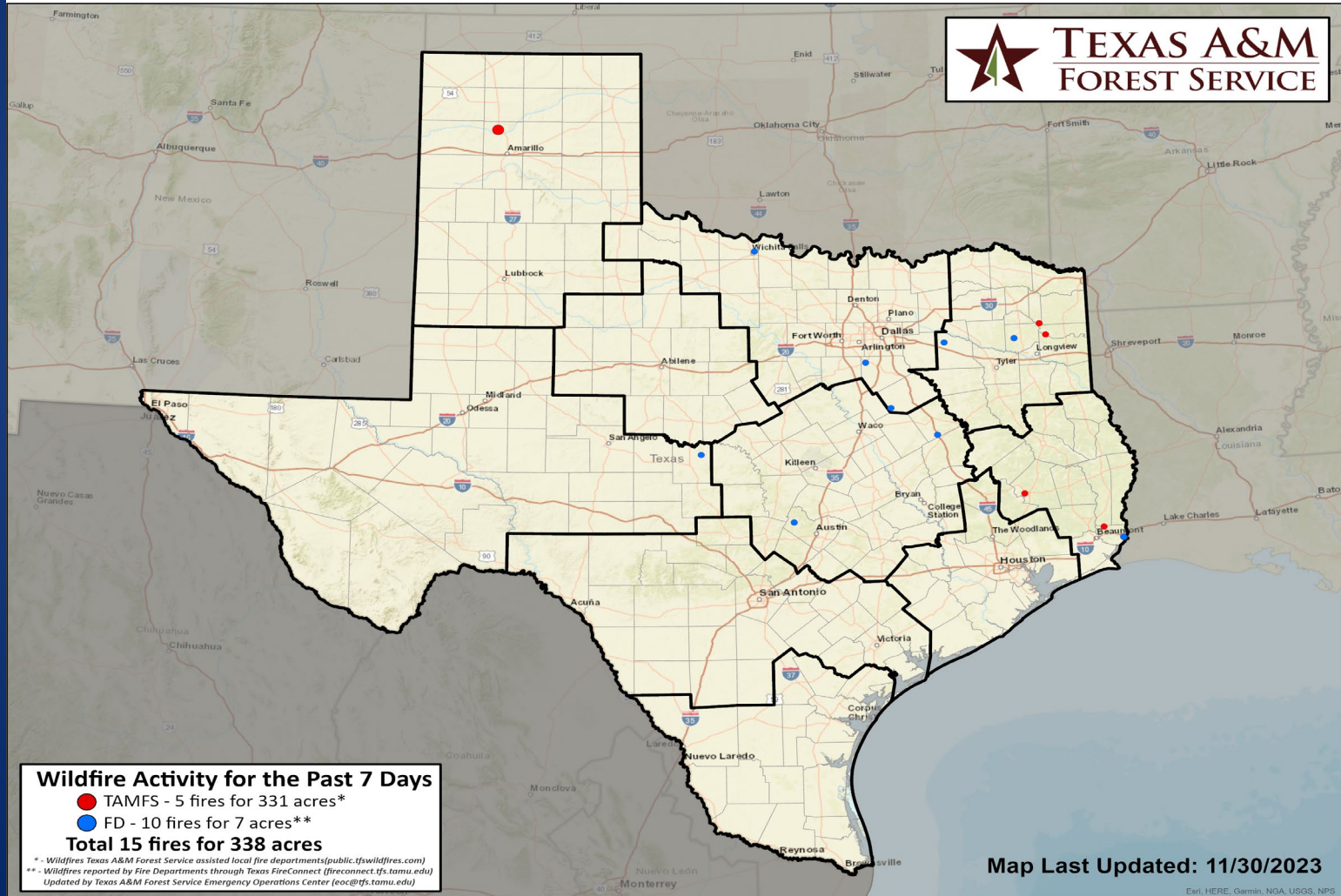

Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Report of 1,222 (+2) fires and 141,785 (+10) acres have been burned this year. There are 67 (-1) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list contains 36 (no change) counties with an average over 400.
