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
Winter weather producing low visibility and slippery roads in **OK/TX** Panhandles this morning.






Today's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities

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A Winter Weather Advisory in effect until 12 PM CT today for **OK/TX Panhandles for low** visibility and slippery roads from snow.


Wind Advisory in effect for SE LA through Saturday for wind gusts up to 40 MPH.



Tomorrow's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities


