


Widespread rain and isolated thunderstorms arrive to North and Central Texas early Friday through Friday night. Average rainfall totals will be near 0.5 to 1.5 inches. No flooding or severe weather is expected, but plan for interruptions to outdoor activities!




Mostly cloudy and warmer. Scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms are expected ahead and along a cold front that will enter the region this evening.

Hazardous Weather




Showers and isolated thunderstorms are likely today across most of South Central Texas. The best chances will be across the north and east. Rainfall totals will range from a few hundredths of an inch to half an inch for most of the area. A few spots could get up to an inch along and east of Hwy 77. High temperatures will be from the lower 60s to around 70.








Burn Ban




