




The combined Panhandles are expecting some below zero wind chills tonight. With the main push of Arctic air coming in Saturday, wind chill values are expected to plunge into teens and 20s, especially Monday night.




Hazardous cold temperatures will arrive late this weekend into early next week. We're looking at overnight lows in the single digits & teens both Sunday night & Monday night. The wind chill values are expected to range from -15 - OF.Continue to monitor the forecast over the next few days and begin taking precautions now to protect the 4 P's: People, Pets, Plants, and Pipes!




A Red Flag Warning will be in effect from 2 AM to 3 PM Friday as very dry and windy conditions develop in the wake of a strong cold front.



A Red Flag Warning is in effect for all of Deep South Texas (except the barrier islands) from 6 AM to 4 PM Today. The combination of low relative humidity and strong winds will result in increased fire weather concerns and rapid spread of any wildfires



DANGEROUS wind chills coming early next week. Wind chills will be in the single digits across the Permian Basin on Sunday morning. Monday morning will be even colder with very cold wind chills stretching down past Marfa. Tuesday morning features the most dangerous wind chills with most locations seing wind chills below 0 and even -10 to -15 degrees. Bundle up!!







Keetch-Byram Drought Index


