

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
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Heavy rain/flash flooding across SETX into SWAR and WLA.






Today's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities



Watches, Warnings, and Advisories Wind, Severe, Winter, and Flood Hazards



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
Winter Weather warning and advisories through noon across OK and AR.


















Tomorrow's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities



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
Heavy rain/flash flooding across SETX, LA into SEAR.
