


Showers and storms return on Friday, though a flooding threat is not expected.



Today will be mostly cloudy with a low chance of showers and perhaps a thunderstorm along the immediate coast up to the Victoria Crossroads.






Widespread rain is expected to develop across the forecast area today with chances ranging from 50-90 percent. Thunderstorms are possible in the southern Rolling Plains where some locations could close to an inch of rainfall. Rain amounts elsewhere are expected to generally range from a tenth of an inch to half an inch.



Fire Danger Forecast




Burn Ban




