
A few severe storms will be possible late Friday afternoon into Friday night. Large hail and damaging winds will be the main concerns.




Widespread showers and thunderstorms are expected tonight into Saturday morning. Initially, a few strong to severe storms with primarily hail are possible across the western counties. Some locally heavy rainfall will be possible across much of Central into East Texas overnight and Saturday where isolated totals could approach 2 inches. Some minor flooding will be possible during this time.



Here are today's expected high temperatures.



There is a level 1 to 2 of 5 risk for severe storms mainly between 7pm this evening and 4am Saturday. Large hail is the primary threat, but damaging straight-line winds or a tornado may also be possible overnight.




There is a chance of showers and thunderstorms today. Greatest chances will be off the Caprock late this afternoon into this evening.



Fire Danger Forecast




