
Strong winds and low humidity will result in a high fire danger along the Rio Grande today. Avoid activities that could inadvertently cause a wildfire.



Critical Fire Weather Conditions is expected from Live Oak to Inland Kleberg westward Sunday. The combination of gusty winds and very low relative humidity values will allow for potentially hazardous conditions.



A Red Flag Warning and a Fire Danger Statement have been issued for 9 AM Sunday until 8 PM Sunday. Extremely dry air and strong northwesterly winds could lead to the rapid spread of fires.



A High Wind Warning is in effect through early this morning for Southeast New Mexico and most of West Texas along and west of the Pecos. A Wind Advisory is in effect through early this morning for most of the Permian Basin. Secure loose objects that may be blown away by strong winds. Keep both hands on the steering wheel as driving may be difficult. Extreme turbulence near the mountains will be dangerous for low-flying light aircraft. Use caution when driving as blowing dust may reduce visibility.




A Rangeland Fire Danger Statement for elevated fire weather is in effect today for Southeast New Mexico and much of West Texas.


