





A few heavy snow bands are expected to develop across the Southern Texas Panhandle into the South Plains of West Texas on Sunday. Just where these bands will set up is still a bit uncertain and could end up further north into the Texas Panhandle. If this occurs, snowfall will be higher than currently forecast. Stay tuned for updates on the situation.



A Winter Storm Watch is in effect for the southern Texas Panhandle into the northern and central South and Rolling Plains from late tonight through late Sunday night. Periods of heavy snow and gusty winds could make travel difficult at times on Sunday. Storm total snowfall across this area could range from 4 to 12 inches by late Sunday night.




A Marginal Risk for severe thunderstorms is highlighted over the southern half of our region from this afternoon through tonight, mainly for the possibility of a few storms containing large hail and damaging wind.



Today, portions of the area are outlined in a Marginal to Slight Risk of Excessive Rainfall along and north of a Sabine Pass to Opelousas line. 1 to 2.5 inches of rainfall, with locally higher amounts, will be possible.




Widespread showers and thunderstorms expected during the day.



Temperatures today will warm into the low 70s to around 80° under mostly cloudy skies. Isolated to scattered showers and thunderstorms are possible today as an upper-level disturbances moves through. A few storms may be strong to severe, generally across the Northern Coastal Plains and Victoria Crossroads.



Multiple rounds of showers and storms will impact south-central Texas Saturday through Sunday morning. There will be a risk of Severe Storms across the region mainly in the mid afternoon through the overnight. Frequent lightning will accompany these storms. Isolated instances of large hail and damaging winds are possible, as well as potentially a tornado.





A Winter Storm Watch is in effect for the Guadalupe and Delaware Mountains. 4-6 inches of snowfall is possible Saturday night through Sunday afternoon. Make preparations now and monitor the forecast this weekend for any updates!






