




A Winter Storm Warning remains in effect for the southern Texas Panhandle into the South and portions of the Rolling Plains from through late tonight. Periods of heavy snow and gusty winds could make travel difficult at times today. Storm total snowfall across the warned area will range from 4 to 8 inches with isolated amount near 12" by late tonight.



A Severe Thunderstorm Watch is now in effect for parts of Central and North Texas until 11 am. Large hail will be the main threat, although damaging winds will also be possible. The tornado threat is low, but lines of storms can many times produce embedded tornadoes.



A Slight Risk for severe thunderstorms is highlighted over the southeast half of our region from this morning through this evening, with a Marginal Risk along the I-20 corridor of Northeast Texas into Southwest Arkansas. The threat is mainly for storms containing damaging wind and possibly large hail. There will be a tornado threat mainly south of the I-20 Corridor of Northeast Texas and Northern Louisiana later this morning and this afternoon.,



A Severe Thunderstorm Watch is in effect for portions of Southeast TX through late morning. Scattered thunderstorms currently over north-central TX will continue to move eastward over the next few hours. Some of these storms could become severe with large hail and damaging winds. Stay tuned and be prepared.




For today there is a Slight Risk (Level 2 of 5) for severe thunderstorms. All modes of severe weather could be possible from the afternoon through the early evening hours.





Severe Thunderstorm Watch 15 in effect through 11 AM CST Sunday. Large hail up to 2.5 inches, damaging wind gusts to 70 mph, and an isolated tornado are possible.



Showers and thunderstorms will move out of the area by mid-day with clearing skies expected for the afternoon. Highs will top out in the 60s to lower 70s. Elevated to near-critical fire weather conditions are expected across the Rio Grande this afternoon.



A Fire Danger Statement is in effect through this evening as a cold front is expected to pass through the area. This will drop relative humidity values as low as 15% across the Brush Country and 25% across the Southern Coastal Bend with winds up to 35 mph.



A Winter Storm Warning is in effect for the Guadalupe and Delaware Mountains where 4-6 inches of snowfall is possible Saturday night through Sunday afternoon. A Winter weather advisory is in effect for northern Lea County including Tatum where 1-3 inches are possible. Make some preparations now and monitor the forecast this weekend for any updates!





Fire Danger Forecast



Keetch-Byram Drought Index


