




Warm and very dry conditions will lead to elevated fire danger this afternoon across much of western Oklahoma and a portion of western north Texas.

A Red Flag Warning remains in effect for this afternoon and evening across Southeast New Mexico, the Trans Pecos, and the western high terrain. Very dry conditions and strong, gusty winds will lead to critical fire weather conditions. Take precautions now to avoid any fire starts Today and obey any burn bans in your area!





Fire Danger Forecast




Burn Ban

Keetch-Byram Drought Index


