
Critical fire weather conditions are expected today across all of the combined Oklahoma and Texas Panhandles between 12 PM and 7 PM. Strong winds and low afternoon relative humidity will be found in these areas. For reference, the risk today is in the first shade of orange shown in the legend.



A Red Flag Warning is in effect today from 11 AM until 7 PM for all counties except Kent, Stonewall, Dickens, King, and Cottle. Strong westerly winds, record heat and very dry conditions will create critical fire weather conditions for much of the region. Avoid outdoor activities that involve sparks or open flames.




Fire weather conditions will be critical on Monday afternoon across western Oklahoma where a Red Flag Warning will be in effect from noon through 7 PM.



A Fire Danger Statement is in effect for the entire area this afternoon, with elevated to near critical fire weather conditions. Critical fire weather conditions will be possible tomorrow.



A Red Flag Warning is in effect from late this morning through early evening for Southeast New Mexico and adjacent areas of West Texas. Conditions will be favorable for fire growth and spread. Properly field-strip cigarettes. Do not burn!




We will have strong winds on Tuesday. A high wind warning is in effect for parts of the region from 11 PM tonight through 11 PM Tuesday night. These areas under the high wind warning will see winds of 35 to 45 with gusts to 60 to 70 mph. A wind advisory is also in effect from 9 AM on Tuesday through 11 PM on Tuesday. These areas under the wind advisory will see winds of 30 to 40 mph with gusts to 60 mph.






