




Wind Speeds


Critical fire weather conditions are expected to continue today as winds out of the southwest gust to 50 mph and humidity drops below 15 percent. Please refrain entirely from outdoor activities that generate sparks or flames.




A Red Flag Warning is in effect tomorrow from 11am to 7pm. Highs in the low 80s and sustained winds of 20 to 30 mph are expected. However, southwesterly winds should keep any smoke from existing fires in the northern Panhandle out of our area.



Critical fire weather conditions are expected across northwestern Oklahoma again Sunday afternoon with winds from the southwest at 15 to 25 mph (gusts to 35 mph) and relative humidity below 15% in the afternoon. Although relative humidity will be a little higher farther east, elevated fire weather conditions will still develop near the I-44 corridor on Sunday afternoon.



Elevated fire danger today.




Critical fire weather conditions are expected across the northern half of the area this afternoon. Be careful about outdoor flames as they could lead to wildfires.






Burn Ban

Keetch-Byram Drought Index


