




Play it safe out there today and exercise wildfire safety!



Chances for showers and thunderstorms will return to the area Monday afternoon through Monday night. The highest rain chances will be roughly along and east of I-35, and a few strong storms with gusty winds and small hail will be possible. Highs will be in the upper 70s to mid 80s with a south wind of 10 to 20 mph.



Showers and storms will return today, increasing in coverage by the afternoon hours. A few storms may be strong to severe, producing small hail and gusty winds.



We are still on track for strong to severe thunderstorms forming this afternoon, with the main threats being large hail and damaging winds. All the forecast areas, including southeast Texas, central Louisiana, and southwest Louisiana, are under a Marginal Risk (1/5) for severe thunderstorms.

Keetch-Byram Drought Index


