- Severe Storms:
  - **Today: Marginal SE LA**
  - Sunday: Slight W OK Ο
  - Monday: Slight SAR, LA, ETX (+ slight risk heavy rainfall) Ο
- Fire Weather:
  - Today: Elevated S NM, WTX Ο
  - Saturday: Elevated S NM, WTX Ο
  - Sunday: Elevated to Critical E NM, TX Panhandle, WTX (+ strong winds) Ο
- Minor river flooding in ETX, LA, AR. Isolated moderate river flooding in **SETX** ends by this evening.




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## 5-Day Precipitation Forecast & River Flood Status



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

## Today's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities



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



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## Elevated fire weather conditions in S NM,WTX.




### Tomorrow's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities

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
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#### Slight risk for severe storms in W OK. Marginal risk in N/Cntl/SW TX, E OK.
