Limited chances are in forecast for a few showers and an isolated thunderstorm or two across the western and southwest zones tonight.




Mostly cloudy. Isolated showers possible. Cannot rule out a rumble of thunderstorm over northern counties.








### Fire Danger Forecast

### **Keetch-Byram Drought Index**


