





One last round of showers and thunderstorms will move across the area today. While the threat for severe storms is low, a few strong storms capable of hail and gusty winds are possible, especially along and east of I-35. In addition, the threat for heavy rain and flooding will continue in parts of Central and East Texas. Rain will exit the area this evening, while gusty northwest winds arrive behind a cold front.



Multiple rounds of heavy rainfall are expected through into Wednesday. Widespread rainfall totals of 4 to 6 inches are expected, with scattered pockets of 6 to 8 inches. Isolated higher amounts are possible. This will likely result in a widespread threat for flooding. Therefore, a Flood Watch remains in effect for the entire Four State Area through Wednesday evening.





Critical fire weather conditions are expected over the Southern Edwards Plateau and Rio Grande Plains this afternoon and evening. Little to no rainfall has fallen in this area and low humidity and gusty wind will allow any fires that develop to guickly spread.



Critical fire weather conditions are expected to develop today as northwesterly winds increase and relative humidity values fall in the wake of a cold front. Relative humidity values will fall to as low as 20% as dry air moves in and northwest winds will increasing with gusts reaching 50 MPH at times. Therefore, a Red Flag Warning remains in effect for the southern islands, Coastal Bend, Brush Country, and Coastal Plains, from 11 AM to 7 PM Today.



A Red Flag Warning is in effect for today from 12PM to 9PM due to the arrival of very dry air and strong northwest winds in wake of the passage of a cold front. Burning of any kind is strongly discouraged. Burn bans remain in effect for the Rio Grande Valley and Deep South Texas ranchlands.








Burn Ban
