Summary of the Upcoming Week

- Slight risk for severe thunderstorms over NAR today; marginal risk over NE AR Wednesday; slight risk over SE OK, AR, NETX on Thursday.
- Elevated to critical fire weather conditions E NM,TX/OK Panhandles, NW OK today; elevated fire weather conditions NE NM, WTX/OK Panhandles.
- Marginal risk for heavy rain/flash flooding over AR today; marginal risk over E OK, AR, NETX, and NW LA on Thursday; marginal risk over S/E OK, N/W AR, N/WTX on Friday; slight risk over E OK, SW AR, NETX, NW LA on Saturday.
- Isolated moderate river flooding in ETX and LA.



Note: Even though the image displays 5 days of forecasted rainfall, river forecasts only include 1-2 days of rainfall





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










Today's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities




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

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



Elevated fire weather conditions over NE NM,WTX/OK Panhandles.




Tomorrow's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities


