






Warm and mostly cloudy. Isolated convection will be possible this evening for the Upper Rio Grande Valley.

Hazardous Weather




Mostly cloudy, warm, and muggy conditions can be expected across south-central Texas today. There is potential for an isolated storm or two to develop in Mexico and drift eastward across the Rio Grande late this afternoon.



Dry conditions with humidity as low as 5 percent will meet with windy conditions out west to create elevated fire weather conditions, mainly in the mountains and surrounding foothills/plains. Secure loose chains, properly dispose of cigarettes, and obey any burn bans.

Fire Danger Forecast



Keetch-Byram Drought Index


