Today continues to present a highly conditional chance for severe storms in the eastern to central Panhandles. While we are not confident storms will develop, if they do, they'll likely be severe, bringing a risk for very large hail, damaging winds, and tornadoes.



Critical fire weather conditions are possible west of the dryline today due to windy and dry conditions.


Warm with highs in the 80s today with clouds clearing through the day from west to east. A dryline will setup near the I-27/US-87 corridor with critical fire weather concerns west of the boundary due to warm, dry and windy conditions. East of the dryline, severe storms are possible this afternoon and into the overnight hours.





A Red Flag Warning is in effect today from noon to 10 pm for the far southwest Texas Panhandle and portions of the western South Plains. Dry, warm, and windy conditions will give way to critical fire weather concerns across the watch area. Plan to avoid any activities that may cause a spark or flame.




Storms are expected to form in the Oklahoma and Texas panhandle Thursday evening and spread east into Oklahoma and north Texas during the late evening and overnight hours. The main threat will be large hail and damaging winds, but there is the potential of tornadoes as well.







A Red Flag Warning is in effect this morning through this evening for southeast New Mexico and most of West Texas. A very dry airmass and strong southwest winds will result in critical to extreme fire weather conditions. Avoid outdoor burning of any kind and properly dispose of cigarettes!



Tonight there is a low risk (10-40%) of severe thunderstorms across the Permian Basin and Lower Trans Pecos. The best chance Of thunderstorms is expected after dark between about 9 PM CDT and AM 4 CDT. It will be important to make sure you have weather alerts to on and have multiple ways to receive set warnings during the overnight hours.







Keetch-Byram Drought Index


