## Summary of the Upcoming Week

- Heavy rainfall/flash flooding:
  - Today (Moderate): SETX (Slight): OK/TX
  - Thursday (Slight): E OK, ETX, AR, NW LA
  - Saturday (Slight): SW OK, NW TX, SE TX Panhandle
- Enhanced to Slight risk for severe thunderstorms today in W OK into NW/W TX and W TX/OK Panhandles. Another Slight Risk Monday for OK/N TX.
- Elevated to Critical fire weather conditions in NM, Far WTX, and WTX/OK
   Panhandles today and Thursday.
- Moderate/Major river flooding in S/NE OK, ETX and LA. Trinity & Neches rivers flooding homes and portions of I-10 and US 59 in SETX.



59.


Neches River near Town Bluff flooding homes in Barlow Lake community.






Slight risk for excessive rainfall/flash flooding for E OK, N/ETX, AR, NW LA.

Elevated fire weather conditions in NM, Far WTX.




#### Tomorrow's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities












