





Showers and even some thunderstorms possible, especially later today, favoring the western Panhandles. Looking ahead to the weekend, rain chances increase for most areas.




To kick off the weekend, expect afternoon highs in the 70s and 80s. Isolated rain chances are possible this afternoon in our far southwest. Better rain and storm chances will come tomorrow afternoon for areas west of I-35.



Much cooler conditions are expected Friday with highs in the 80s. Isolated showers and storms are possible along the Rio Grande.





A cold front has brought increased moisture into the area. An approaching upper disturbance will cause rain chances to increase today in the lower Trans Pecos and Big Bend, then spread north and east into the remainder of the area. Rain amounts will range from a couple of tenths of an inch in the west to an inch or more in the eastern Permian Basin.





## **Keetch-Byram Drought Index**


