- Slight risk for severe storms from CtrITX into LA today and over CtrI/NE/E/SETX, LA, SAR on Monday.
- Moderate risk of heavy rainfall/areal flash flooding over E/SETX and W LA today and over far SE LA on Monday; slight risk for heavy rainfall on Monday over the remainder of LA into SETX
- Threat for heavy rainfall/flash flooding returns over CtrlTX on Wednesday and over E/SETX, LA on Thursday
- Elevated to critical fire weather conditions Sunday over S NM and W TX
- Moderate to major river flooding continues across E/SETX with minor river flooding across LA.





**Moderate to major river flooding** continues across E/SETX into next week. Homes, roads, and agricultural areas are flooded. **Minor river flooding is expected** over LA.

Additional rainfall on Sunday/Monday over E/SETX will prolong current river flooding and may result in additional river flooding, but will not increase river levels to where they were last week.



## Today's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities












### Tomorrow's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities






