

Severe thunderstorms are possible once again this evening into early Saturday morning. The higher potential for a few severe storms is across the west and northwest. Large hail and damaging wind gusts are the primary hazards with any severe storms tonight.




Isolated to scattered thunderstorms are expected to develop in eastern New Mexico and move eastward into the South Plains region this evening through tonight. The highest storm chances will be near the TX/NM state line.

Some strong to severe storms will be possible late Friday evening into early Saturday. Strong winds and hail will be possible.



The Flood Watch has been cancelled for most of North Texas as the heavy rain has ended for this area. However, the watch continues for Central Texas through this evening. Additional 1 to 2 inches of rain can be expected in this area. A few locations could see rainfall amounts exceeding 3 inches. Use extra caution at low water crossing and in areas of poor drainage. Turn around, don't drown!

Excessive rainfall could lead to flash flooding across our Four-State area today and into late this evening. Therefore, a Flood Watch is in effect through 1 AM Saturday.




Isolated to scattered severe thunderstorms will be possible today through this evening with damaging winds and flooding rains the most likely threats. However, a low-end threat of tornadoes will also be possible.



Scattered storms will organize over Eastern Tx with coverage spreading Eastward across southern and central portions of Louisiana through the afternoon / evening.

#### WHAT

 Multiple disturbances moving through the region combined with abundant moisture will bring the potential for strong to severe storms and locally heavy rainfall.

- · Strong to severe thunderstorms possible.
- <u>Slight risk</u> (level 2 of 5) exists for all of Southeast Texas.
- Heavy rainfall could result in flash flooding. Rain rates of 1 to 3 inches per hour possible.
- <u>Slight risk</u> (level 2 of 4) exists for most of Southeast Texas, except the coastal counties where there is a Marginal risk (level 1 of 4).


- · Main threat is damaging winds, followed by large hail
- Brief tornado cannot be ruled out
- Minor urban and small stream flooding the most likely impact, but localized flash flooding is possible.

ISSUED: 3:57 AM - Friday, May 31, 2024

Strong to severe thunderstorms will be possible through Friday capable of producing strong wind gusts, hail and locally heavy rainfall. An isolated tornado or two will also be possible. Stay weather aware. Be sure you have multiple ways to receive the alerts, especially before head to bed tonight.




A Heat Advisory is in effect from 1 PM today until 7 PM this evening for portions of Deep South Texas and the Rio Grande Valley.



A Heat Advisory will be in effect through 7 PM for portions of the Coastal Bend and Brush Country. Heat indices will be in excess of 110°F or higher in these areas. Stay hydrated and be sure to take breaks and look before you lock!



Scattered Storms Today, Some Will Be Strong to Severe Austin/San Antonio, TX

Scattered storms over most of south central Texas are in the forecast today. One round of storms is ongoing this morning, with more development possible this afternoon. A few strong to severe storms along with locally heavy rainfall are possible. Highs will be in the mid 80s to near 100 degrees.



Scattered showers and storms will continue to develop across West Central Texas this morning, with best chances across the Big Country and Heartland and decreasing chances south across the Northern Edwards Plateau.


