Severe storms will be possible once again this afternoon through the evening hours across the Texas and Oklahoma Panhandles. Large hail and damaging wind gusts will continue to be the primary hazards with any severe storms.



Severe thunderstorms are possible across most of the region today. Storms will initially develop over the far southwestern Texas Panhandle and South Plains this afternoon before western shifting eastward over the rest of the region this evening.







Additional isolated to scattered storms are expected this afternoon. We are confident at least some storms will develop, but are still unsure exactly where the storms will develop. Today's storms will have a low wind/hail risk. A line of Will into North storms move Texas late tonight/early Monday morning, after 3 AM. These storms will have a damaging wind risk.




Muggy conditions with another chance of scattered showers and thunderstorms. Isolated stronger thunderstorms capable of strong winds and hail are possible.




Isolated to scattered thunderstorms will clear by mid to late morning. Otherwise, it will be hot and humid today under partly cloudy skies.



An isolated strong to severe thunderstorm is possible across the region this afternoon and evening.



A Heat Advisory is in effect from 1 PM CDT to 9 PM CDT today for the Chinati Mountains, Davis Mountains and Foothills, and Brewster County. Temperatures 95 to 97 degrees are expected in the mountains, and up to 112 degrees along the Rio Grande. Drink plenty of water, wear lightweight, loose fitting, light colored clothing, and remember that prolonged exposure could result in heat related illness.



There will be a low risk for severe thunderstorms across the Permian Basin and Trans Pecos this afternoon and evening. Large hail and strong winds will be the main threats.


