

Strong to severe thunderstorms will be possible across most of the Texas and Oklahoma Panhandles today. The primary hazards with any severe storm will be large hail up to ping pong ball size and wind gusts up to 70 mph gusts.



Hazardous Weather




Triple-digit temperatures are expected across most of the forecast area today with a southerly breeze between 15-25 mph. The development of a few thunderstorms will be possible across the far southern Texas Panhandle and portions of the South Plains by the evening hours. 

Fire Danger Forecast




