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Summary of the Upcoming Week

- Marginal risk of severe storms in E NM,TX/OK Panhandles into SWTX today.
- Heavy rainfall potential in S/SETX and S LA through Wednesday, spreading to SWTX Thursday.
- Elevated to critical fire weather conditions in W NM today into Tuesday.
- Moderate with isolated Major river flooding in ETX.
- High chance (70%) for tropical development in the Bay of Campeche in the next 7 days and a medium chance (60%) in the next 48 hrs. Heavy rain, coastal flooding, rip currents & high seas across the Gulf Coast from STX into LA.





Note: Even though the image displays 5 days of forecasted rainfall, river forecasts only include 1-2 days of rainfall







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

Today's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities




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

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

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

Tomorrow's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities


