Tide levels remain high today with coastal flooding ongoing. Additionally, there is a high risk for dangerous rip currents along gulf facing beaches through Saturday.




A Coastal Flood Advisory is in effect through 7 PM this evening along the Lower Texas beaches and coastal Cameron, Willacy, and Kenedy counties. Nuisance flooding is expected, with water reaching or pushing into the dunes on SPI. Structural damage to any loose structures, boats, and boat ramps unprotected by seawalls may occur.



Fire Danger Forecast




Burn Ban




