
A Heat Advisory is in effect from 1 PM this afternoon through 7 PM Tuesday.



A Coastal Flood Advisory is in effect through 7 PM Monday evening along the Lower Texas beaches and coastal Cameron, Willacy, and Kenedy counties. Nuisance flooding is expected, with water reaching or pushing into the dunes on SPI. Minor to moderate beach erosion is expected.



Tide levels remain elevated today with coastal flooding expected, accompanied by a high risk for dangerous rip currents along gulf facing beaches through this evening.


