




A Heat Advisory is in effect for locations along and east of the I- 35 corridor Monday and Tuesday. Heat index values up to 109 expected. Hot temperatures and high humidity will increase the risk for heat-related illnesses to occur, particularly for those working or participating in outdoor activities. Drink plenty of fluids, stay in an air-conditioned room, stay out of the sun, and check up on relatives and neighbors. Young children and pets should never be left unattended in vehicles under any circumstances.




A Heat Advisory remains in effect until 7 PM Tuesday. Extensions to the heat advisory will be needed and evaluated in the coming days.




A Heat Advisory is in effect from Noon to 7 pm CDT for portions of upper southeast Texas, as well as, central and south central Louisiana.




A Coastal Flood Advisory remains in effect for the Bolivar Peninsula through Monday evening.



A Coastal Flood Advisory is in effect through 7 PM this evening along the Lower Texas beaches and coastal Cameron, Willacy, and Kenedy counties. Nuisance flooding is expected, with water reaching or pushing into the dunes on SPI. Minor to moderate beach erosion is expected.



Dangerous swimming conditions continue due to elevated seas and swell periods. Conditions will continue to improve today but expect the hazards to linger into the work week.





Fire Danger Forecast




Burn Ban




