


A few strong to severe thunderstorms may form across the Panhandles late this afternoon into the evening hours. The primary hazard will be damaging wind gusts up to 70 mph, but isolated large hail cannot be ruled out. Moderate to heavy rainfall may also occur with some of the storms.



There is a slight chance of thunderstorms Tuesday night and Wednesday. The potential for severe weather will remain low, but a few storms may be strong. Unfortunately, it will remain hot and humid outside of any storms.




