







Today, there is a slight risk for severe thunderstorms in the northeastern Panhandles, while only marginal risk for severe storms exists across much of the rest of the Texas Panhandle. Damaging winds, large hail, and heavy rainfall are the primary concerns; however, a tornado or two cannot be ruled out in the slight risk area. Stay tuned for further updates.




Hot temperatures and high humidity today will result in heat index values as high as 109 degrees. A Heat Advisory remains in effect until 8 PM CDT this evening for the extreme southeastern Texas Panhandle and eastern Rolling Plains.




A Heat Advisory is now in effect through 7 pm Thursday evening for all of North and Central Texas. High temperatures will be between 93 and 103 degrees with heat index values between 105-112 degrees for most locations. Ensure you drink plenty of water and limit time spent outdoors during the warmest part of the day.





The Heat Advisory has been extended through late this afternoon. Expect heat index values up to 108°F.




