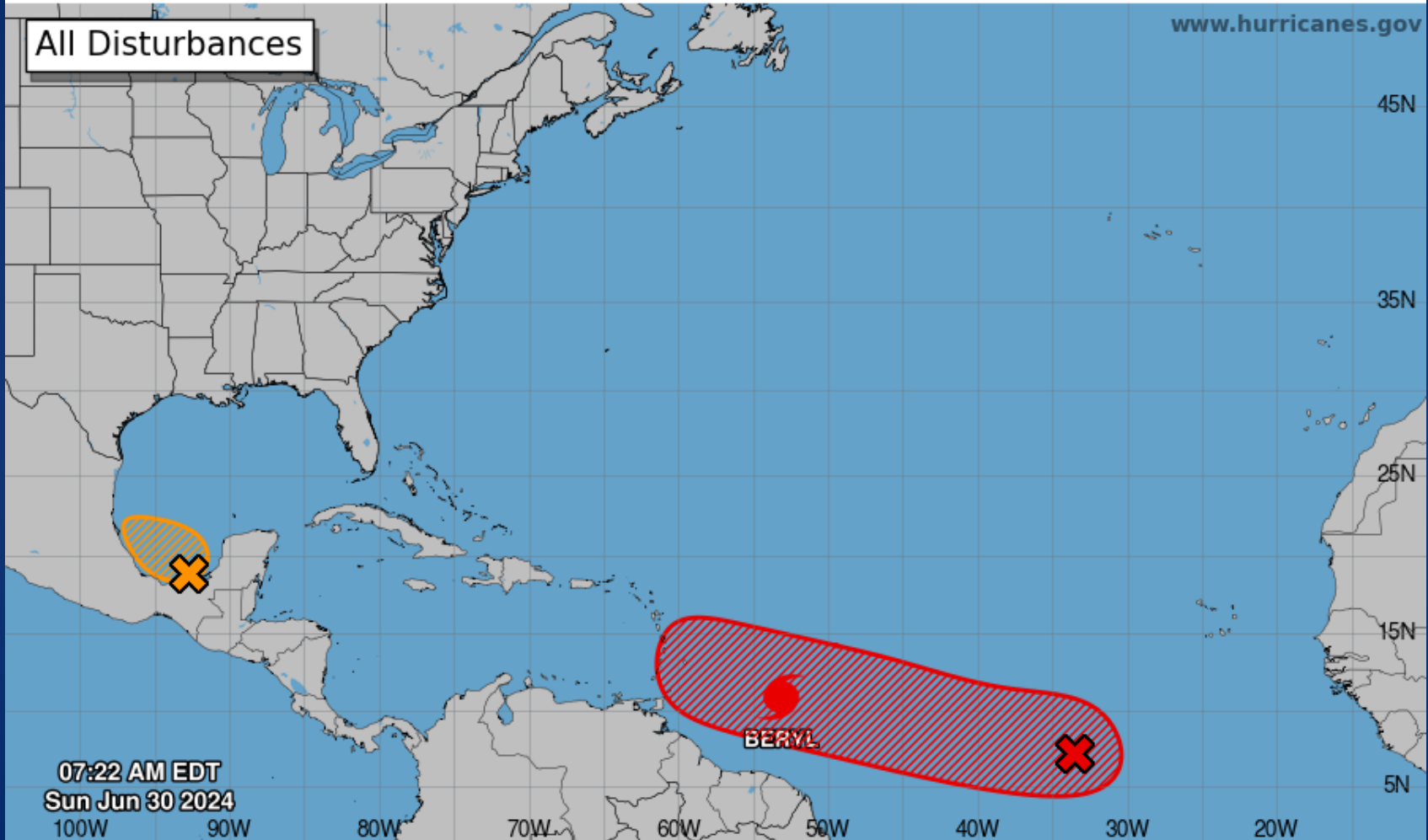
## Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

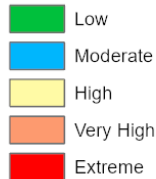

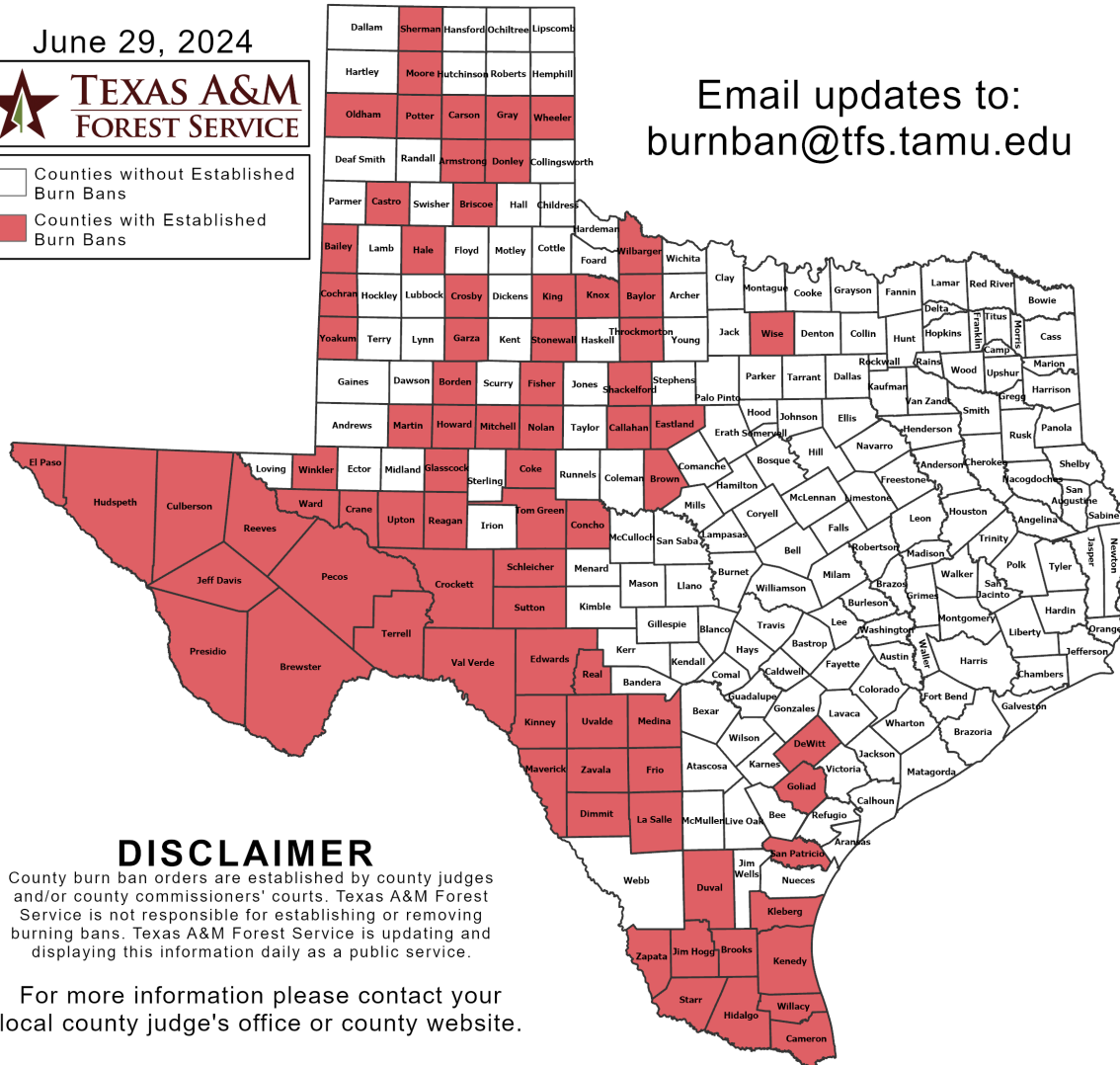

## Keetch-Byram Drought Index

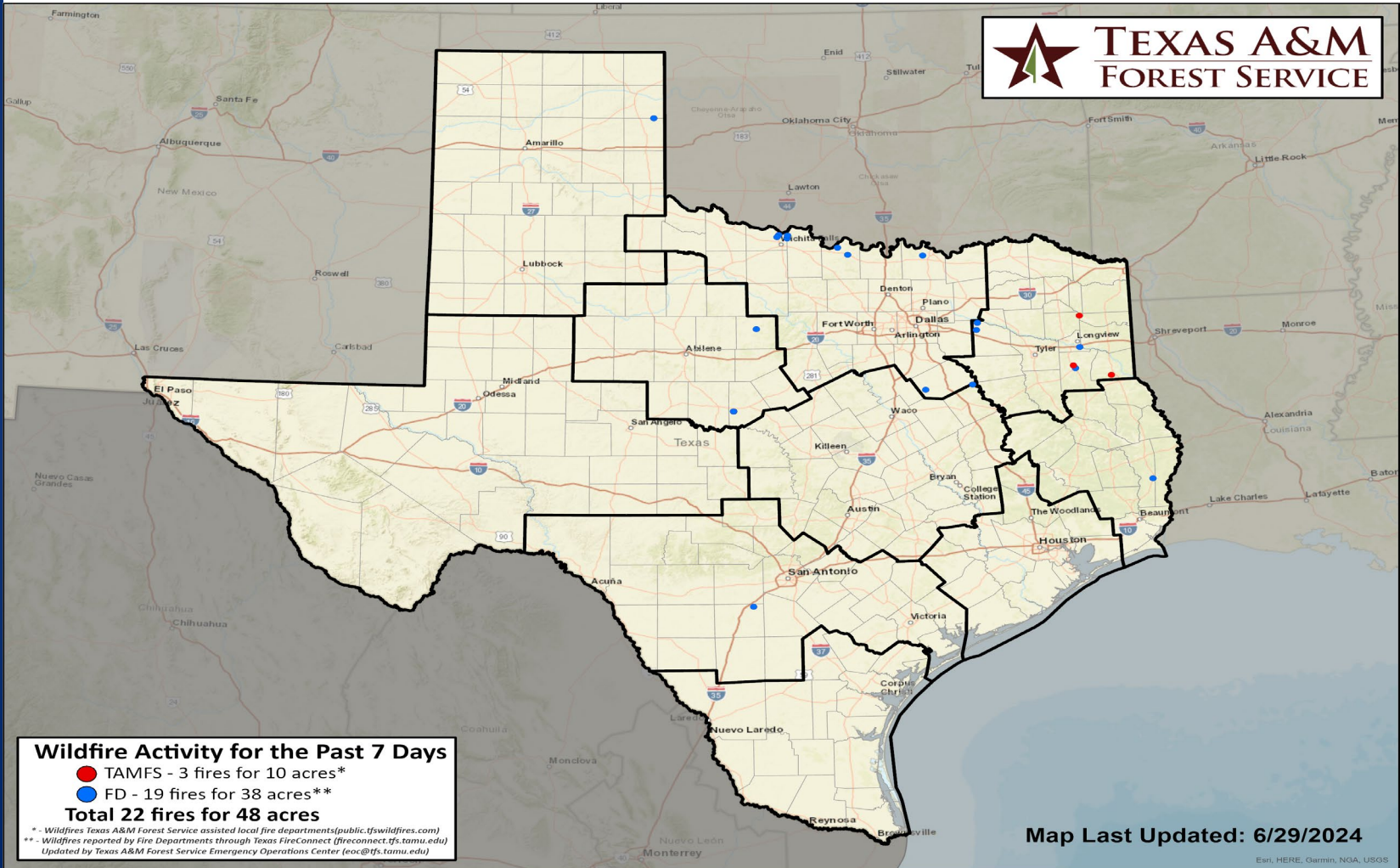

# Fire Activity (\*Last 24 Hours)

Report of 195 (No Change) fires and 1,249,738 (No Change) acres have been burned this year. There are 79 (No Change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list contains 109 (+14) counties with an average over 400.
