



Some of the thunderstorms this morning may produce heavy rain with rain rates around one inch or greater per hour.




Scattered thunderstorms are forecast to develop across portions of the Caprock and Rolling Plains today. Temperatures will be much cooler beneath a dense overcast as well, and the highest storm chances are near the Texas/New Mexico state line. Localized flash flooding and locally damaging wind gusts will be possible.











**Heat Advisory is in effect through Friday.** 



Under mostly sunny skies, seasonably hot temperatures continue with highs in the upper 90s to near 102. Isolated showers and thunderstorms are possible across northern portions of the Hill Country and Edwards Plateau this afternoon into evening. Those spending time outdoors should stay hydrated with water and take frequent breaks out of the sun to minimize risk of heat related illness.






Slightly below normal temperatures are expected today behind a weak cold front moving through the area. Lift behind the front will bring a chance for showers and isolated thunderstorms across the area.




### Fire Danger Forecast
