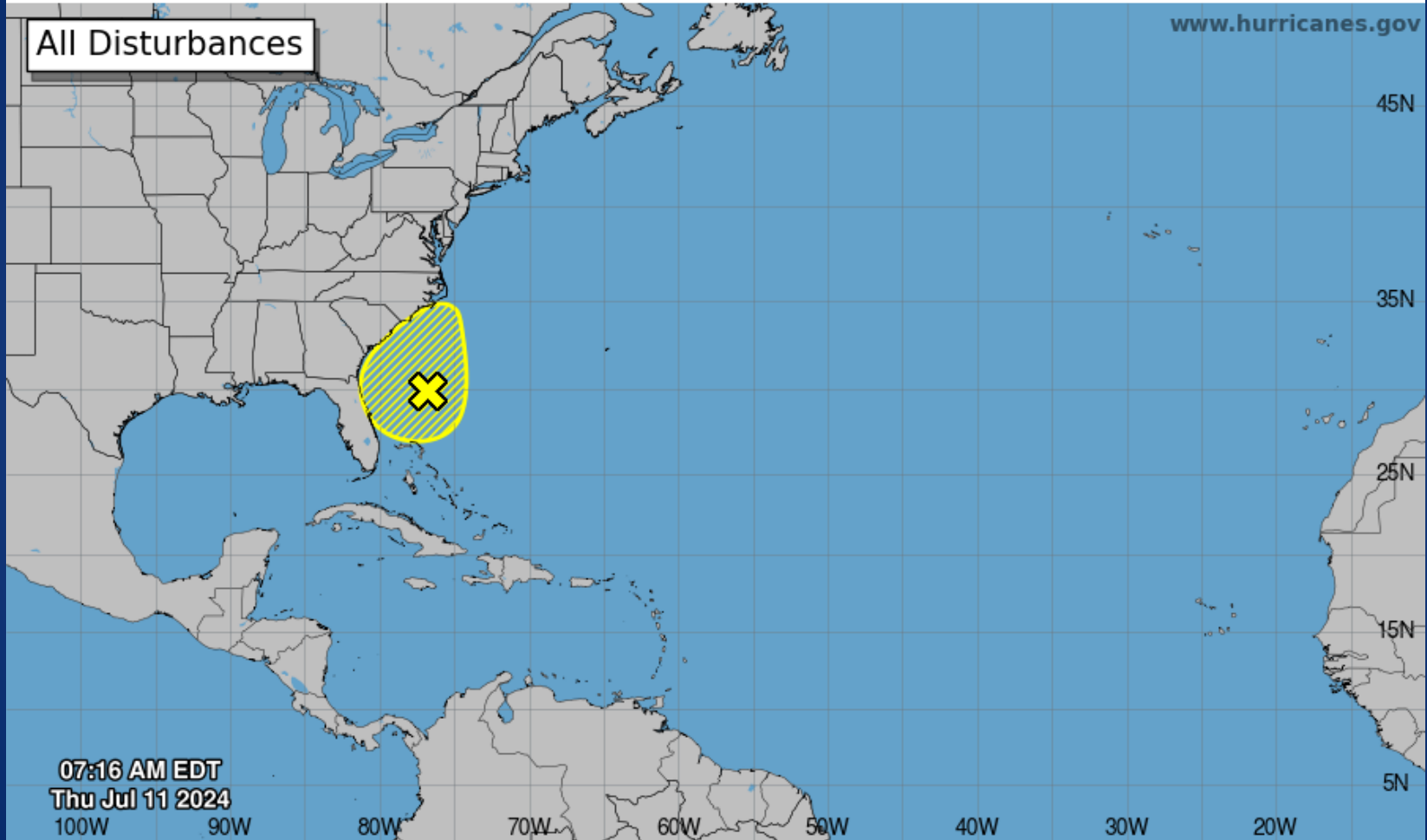
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

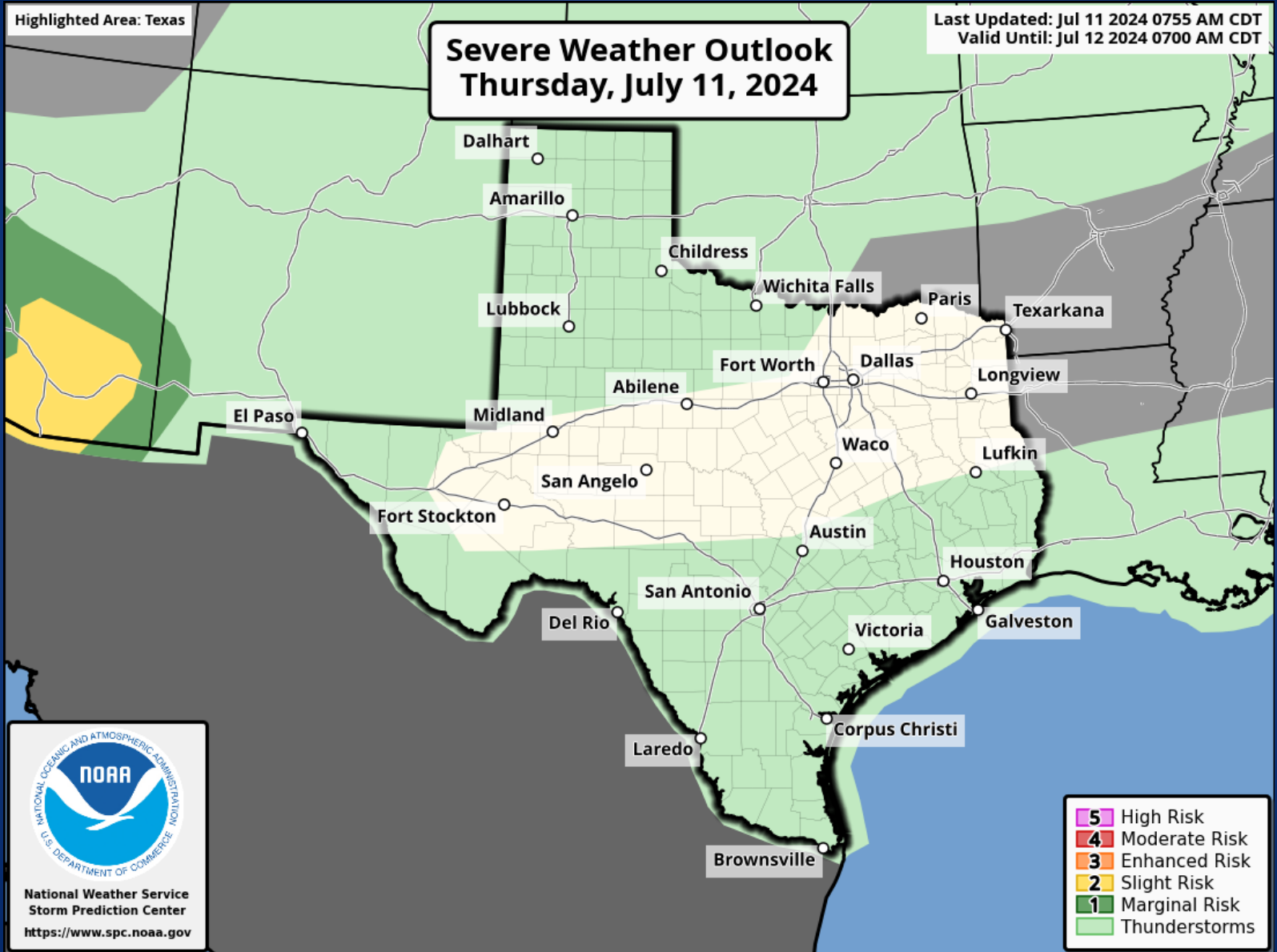


Wind Speeds

Isolated to widely scattered showers and thunderstorms are expected mainly over southern areas. A few strong storms could produce locally heavy downpours more than 1 inch and gusty winds. Seasonably warm high temperatures in the 90s can be expected.

Hazardous Weather



Upper flow will turn from north to northeast with perhaps a bit drier air aloft moving. Hence, although we are still expecting scattered thunderstorms in the afternoon, the activity may be slightly less than today. Some storms may still produce strong winds, moderate hail and localized flooding.

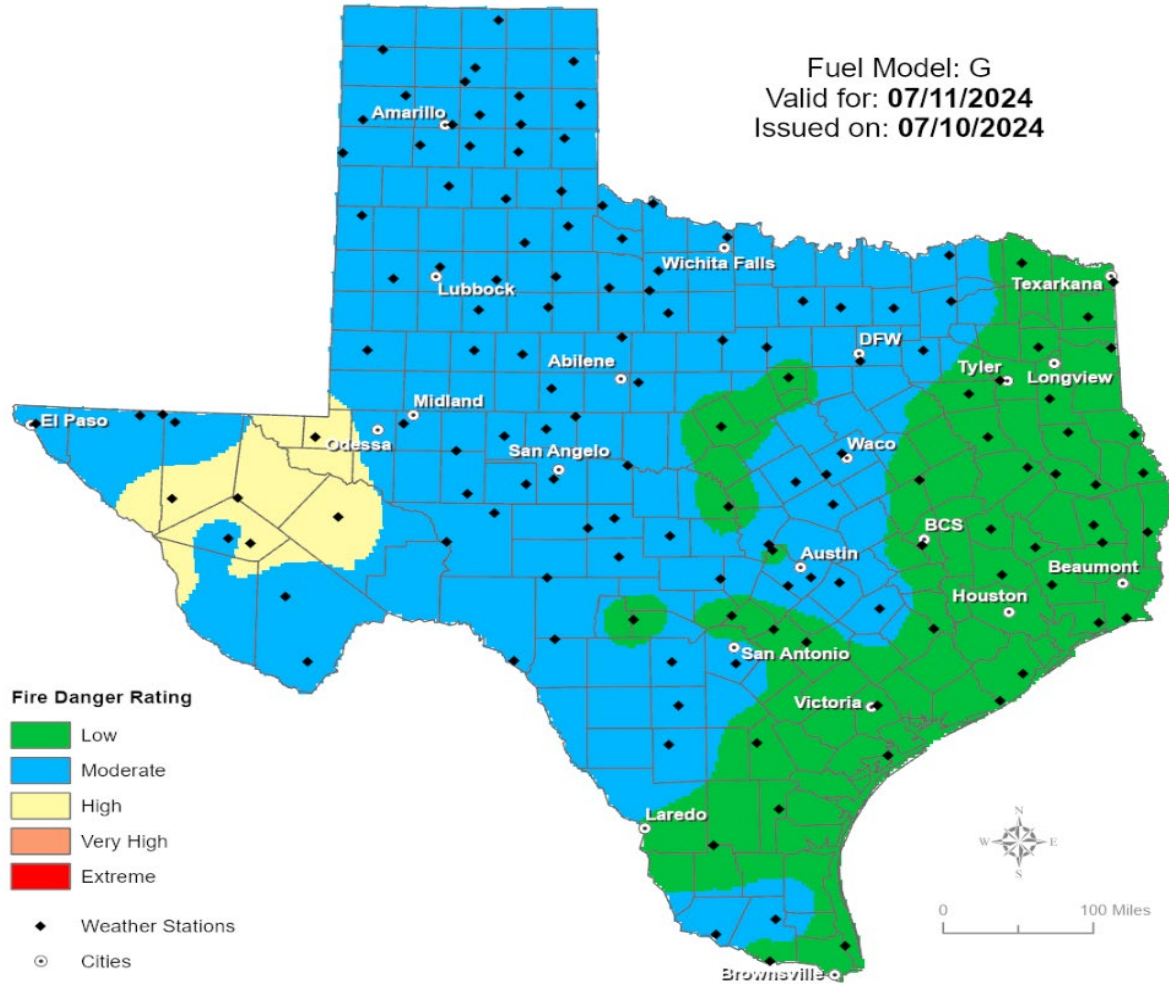

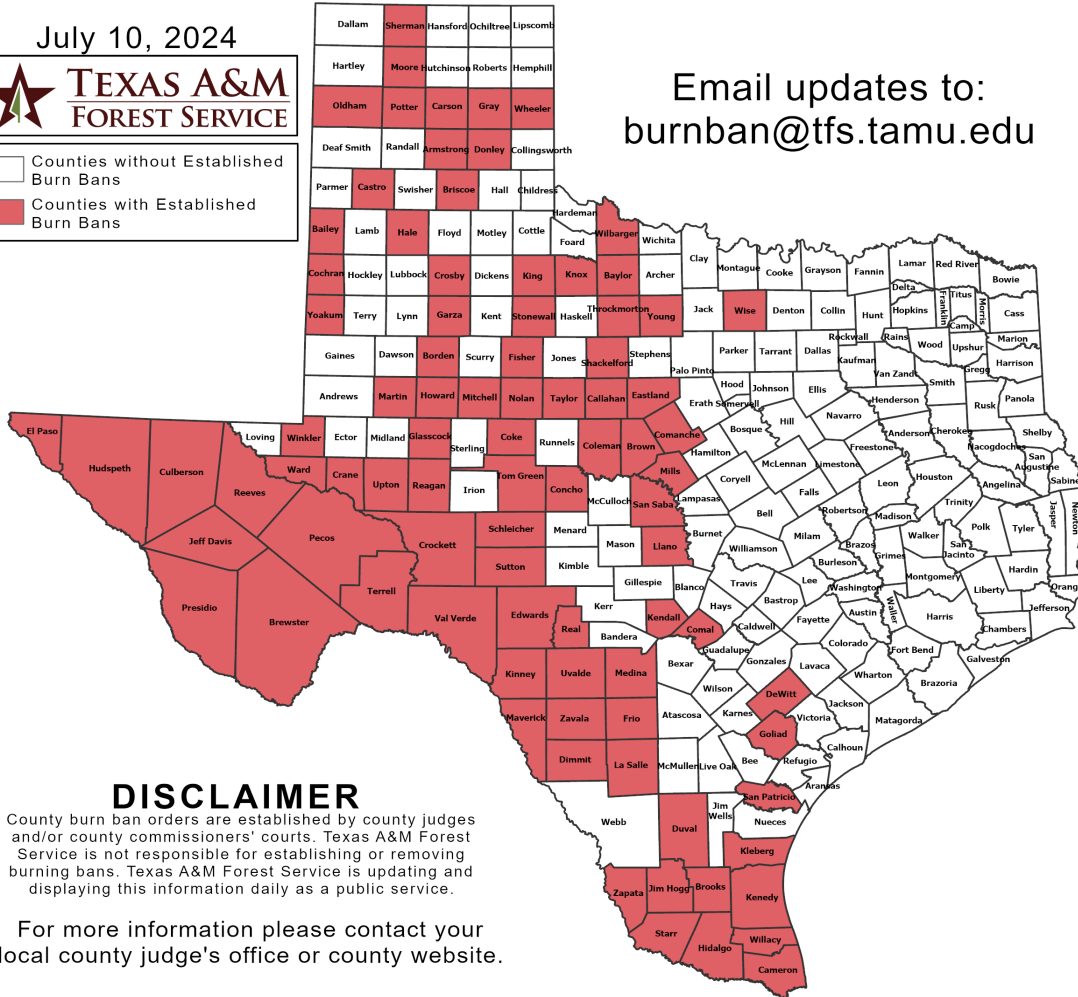

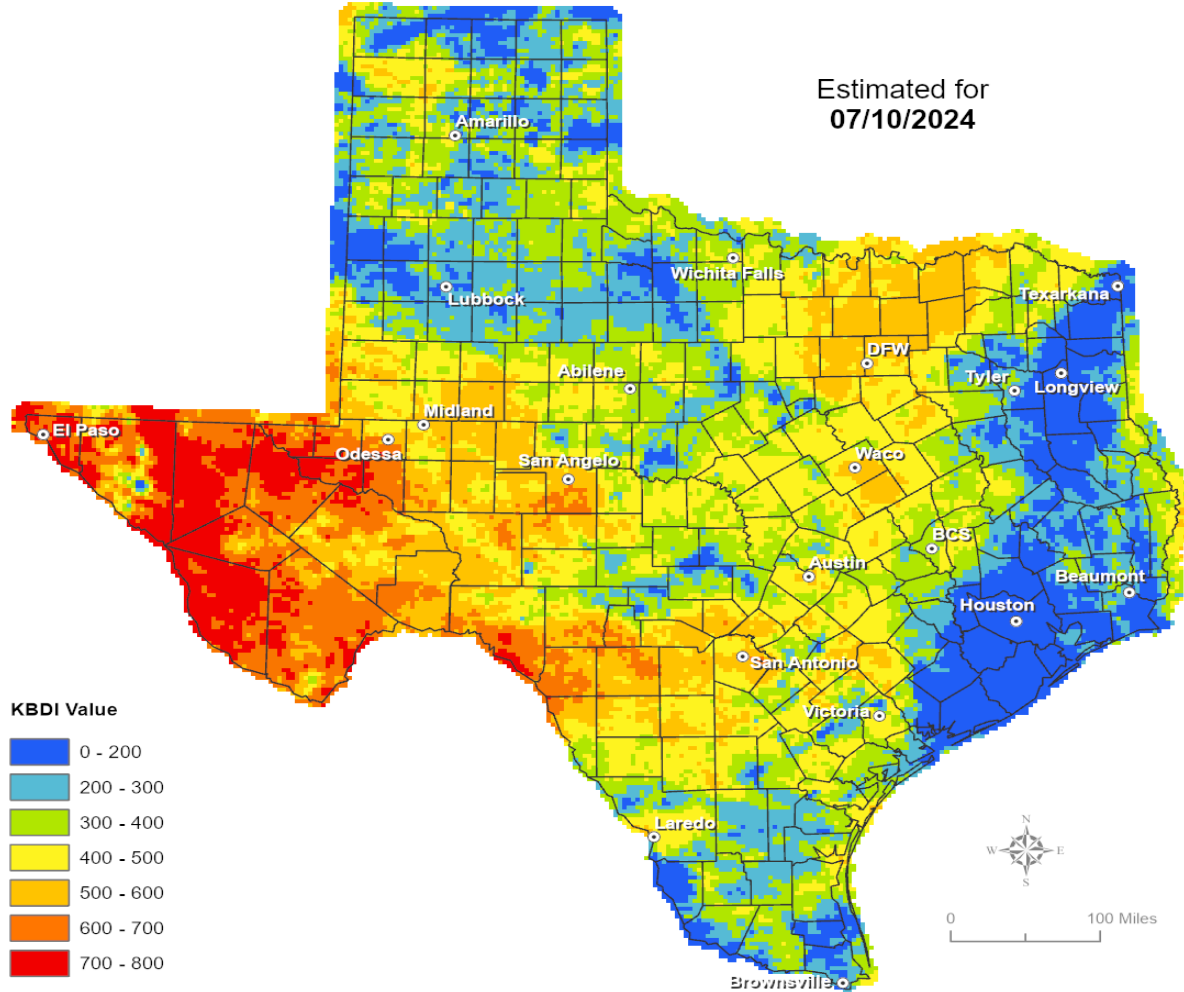

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

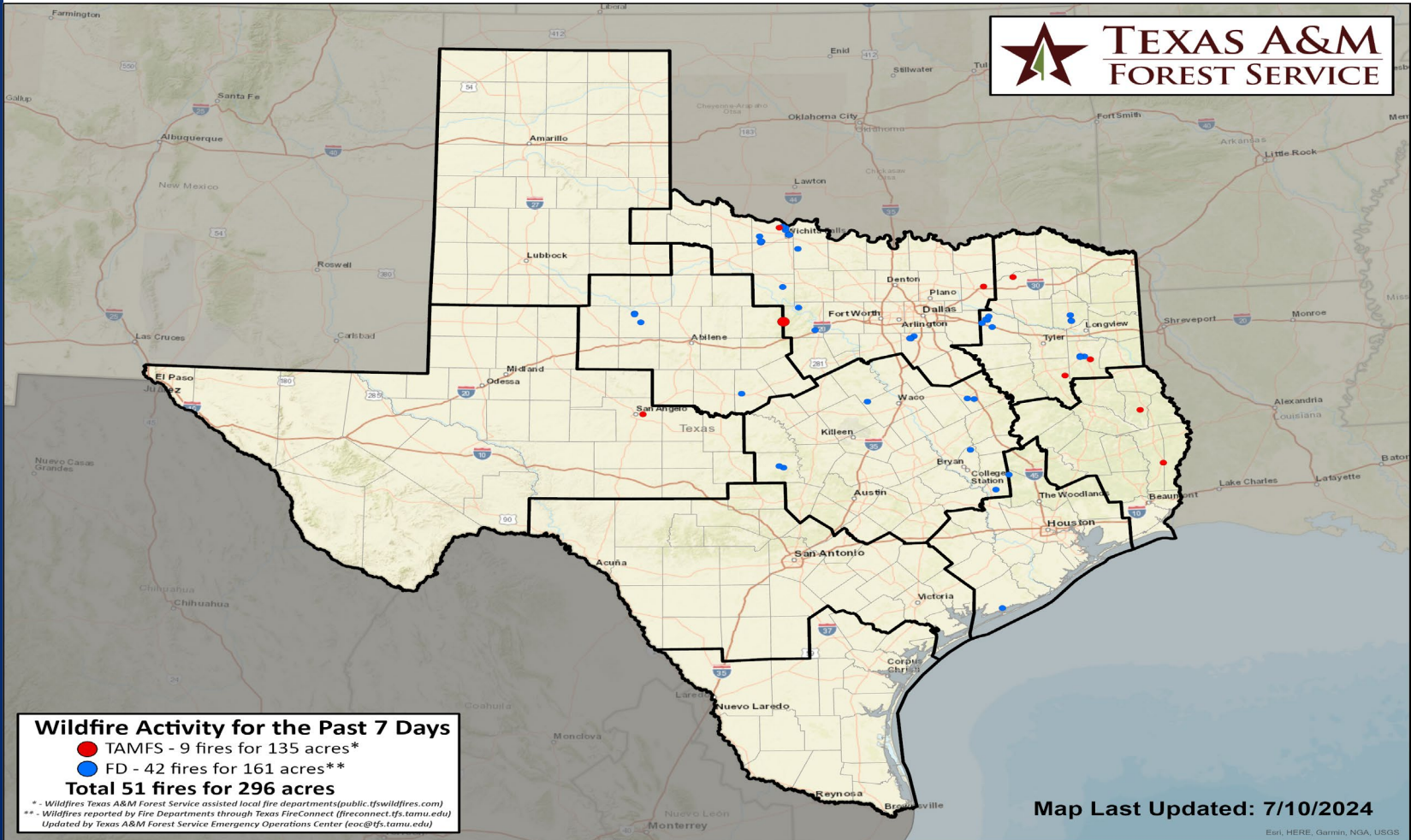
