




Scattered showers and thunderstorms likely once again.

Temperatures will be near seasonal normal values today, mainly in the 90s across the area. While most of the area will be dry, a few showers or storms are possible around the Victoria Crossroads.




Isolated showers or thunderstorms could be possible around the Hallettsville area, but more stable weather is expected for most of South Central Texas today. High temperatures will return to near normal, and heat indices will be on the rise again with some values over 100 expected near and east of I-35.






Burn Ban





Report of 210 (+1) fires and 1,250,058 (+47) acres have been burned this year. There are 91 (No Change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 111 (+3) counties with an average over 400.
