Another round of showers and storms will be possible today across the Panhandles. Main severe concern will be 70 mph winds but will not rule out 1" hail. Moderate to heavy rain is expected with any of the storms that form today.




Scattered thunderstorms are expected to develop over most of the region this afternoon. The chance of rain at any given location today is about 40%. Temperatures will be seasonably warm with highs mainly in the mid 90s.




A few strong to severe thunderstorms are possible across western Oklahoma and western-north Texas on Saturday afternoon and evening. Damaging wind gusts and large hail are both possible.




Storm chances will steadily increase this weekend. While many areas will stay dry today, there are low chances for showers and storms across western North Texas. Scattered to numerous storms are expected on Sunday ahead of a weak cold front. Highs will mostly be in the low to mid 90s.




Highs today will climb into the low 90s to around 100° under partly cloudy skies. Heat indices from 105-109° will promote a moderate risk of heat-related impacts today. There is a 20-35% chance of showers and storms today, with the best chances over the waters this morning and across the Victoria Crossroads this afternoon.



Hot and mostly dry conditions continue today. There remains low chances for an isolated thunderstorm over the coastal plains this afternoon.









#### **Burn Ban**




#### **Keetch-Byram Drought Index**
