





The potential is there for multiple rounds of showers and thunderstorms this evening through Saturday morning for the Texas and Oklahoma Panhandles. These thunderstorms could produce heavy rainfall, with the central and northwestern Panhandles favored at seeing rainfall rates of 1 inch per hour or higher. Be prepared for potential flash flooding, especially in low lying and urban areas this evening through tonight!




Clouds will linger across the region today with a diminishing east wind. Isolated storm chances will return by the late-afternoon hours across the extreme southwestern Texas Panhandle. Temperatures today will be nearly 15 degrees cooler than yesterday.




The ongoing Heat Advisory will remain in effect for portions of Central Texas through 9 pm Friday. Scattered storms may provide relief for some locations, but most locations will miss out on rain entirely. Ensure you continue to practice heat safety by staying hydrated and taking frequent breaks in the shade or indoors if spending time outside.




A weak cold front is pushing through the region, leading to isolated to scattered showers and storms. Very isolated storms across North Texas this morning will gradually spread into Central Texas this afternoon and evening. Best potential for storms is across Central Texas. Severe weather is not expected, but some storms could produce gusty winds. Not everyone will see rain.





## Fire Danger Forecast




#### **Burn Ban**

#### **Keetch-Byram Drought Index**


