


Excessive Heat Warnings and Heat Advisories continue through Wednesday.



An Excessive Heat Warning is in effect today from Noon through 8 PM for a large portion of S TX and a Heat Advisory is in effect for the Rio Grande Plains and southern Brush country. Heat index values 110 to 118 are expected. Please use caution if you must be outside: drink plenty of water, take breaks, and wear light colored, loose clothing. LOOK BEFORE YOU LOCK!



The combination of high temperatures and relative humidity will produce dangerous heat conditions for a large portion of Deep South Texas and the Rio Grande Valley. As a result, a Heat Advisory is in effect for the afternoon and early evening hours of Wednesday.



An Excessive Heat Warning continues for eastern Hill Country, I-35 Corridor, and Coastal Plains, while a Heat Advisory continues for the rest of South Central Texas. These are in effect through 9 PM CDT today.






Fire Danger Forecast

Keetch-Byram Drought Index


