## Summary of the Upcoming Week

- Slight risk of excessive rainfall across NW NM today and over NM burns scars Friday into next week.
- Excessive heat across NM, SW OK, TX through Friday and NM, W/STX through the weekend.
- Elevated risk for significant wildfires across SW OK, NW TX through the weekend.
- No tropical impacts to FEMA 6 expected for the next 7 days.





Note: Even though the image displays 5 days of forecasted rainfall, river forecasts only include 1-2 days of rainfall














### Tomorrow's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities




