

The chances of storms looks to be more favorable to the west today, and tomorrow may be similar as we await this next weather system on Thursday, which should bring a pretty good chance of showers and storms for most of the area.




Scattered afternoon showers and storms are expected today and Wednesday, mainly across Central Texas. High temperatures will be in the mid and upper 90s. No severe weather is expected, but gusty winds and heavy rain may accompany any more robust storm.



Highs in the low 90s. Isolated to scattered showers and thunderstorms expected during the day, mainly south of I-10.



Scattered showers and thunderstorms continue today, peaking in the afternoon over the Victoria Crossroads area. Light east to southeasterly winds will persist with stronger gusty winds associated with downpours and outflows. Highs in the 90s with heat index values 100-108.






Active weather will continue as an inverted trough lingers across our area. The best chance for showers and thunderstorms will be in the afternoon. However, a few storms will be possible before noon. The main concerns with these storms will be heavy rainfall that can lead to flash flooding, gusty winds and small sized hail. The skies will be mostly cloudy with the afternoon high temperatures slightly below the climatological normal.




Fire Danger Forecast



Burn Ban




Keetch-Byram Drought Index
