
Get ready for multiple rounds of rain and thunderstorms beginning Friday night and ending Monday night. Locally heavier amounts of 5 to 8 inches are possible.




An active weather pattern will bring periodic chances for showers and thunderstorms over the weekend to North Texas and portions of Central Texas. Heavy rainfall and strong to severe storms will be possible at times. The best potential for severe weather and localized flash flooding will be along/north of I-20. Check for forecast updates through the weekend and make sure you have multiple ways to receive warnings!

A dry-line will move in from the east Friday afternoon and evening. This will rapidly raise moisture in the east, mainly from El Paso east, and create isolated thunderstorms. A few thunderstorms could become strong with small hail and wind gusts to 50 mph. Temperatures will remain seasonable.



Severe thunderstorms are possible across much of the region late this afternoon into tonight. The strongest thunderstorms may produce torrential rainfall, large hail, and damaging winds. Have multiple ways to receive warnings this evening and tonight.




