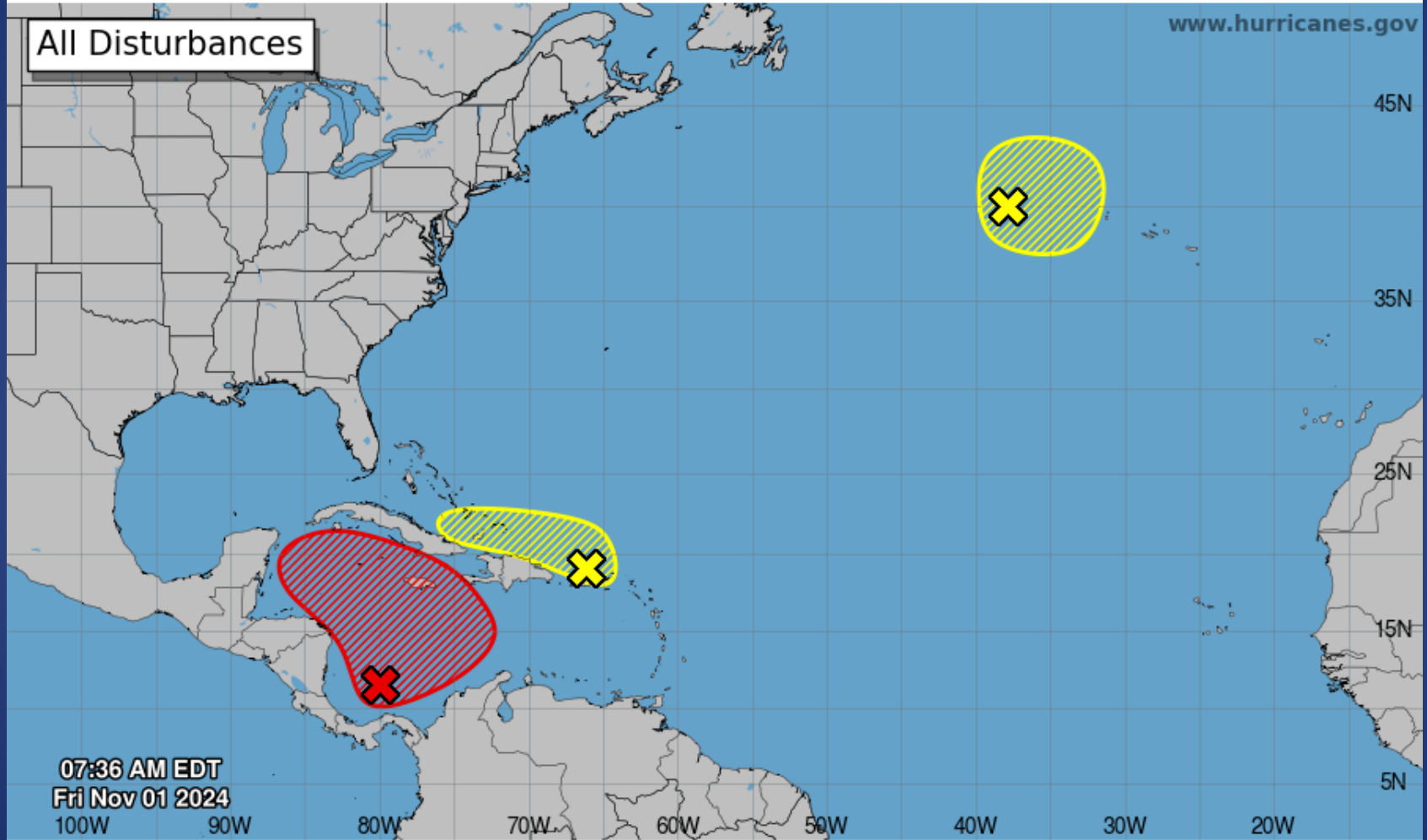
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

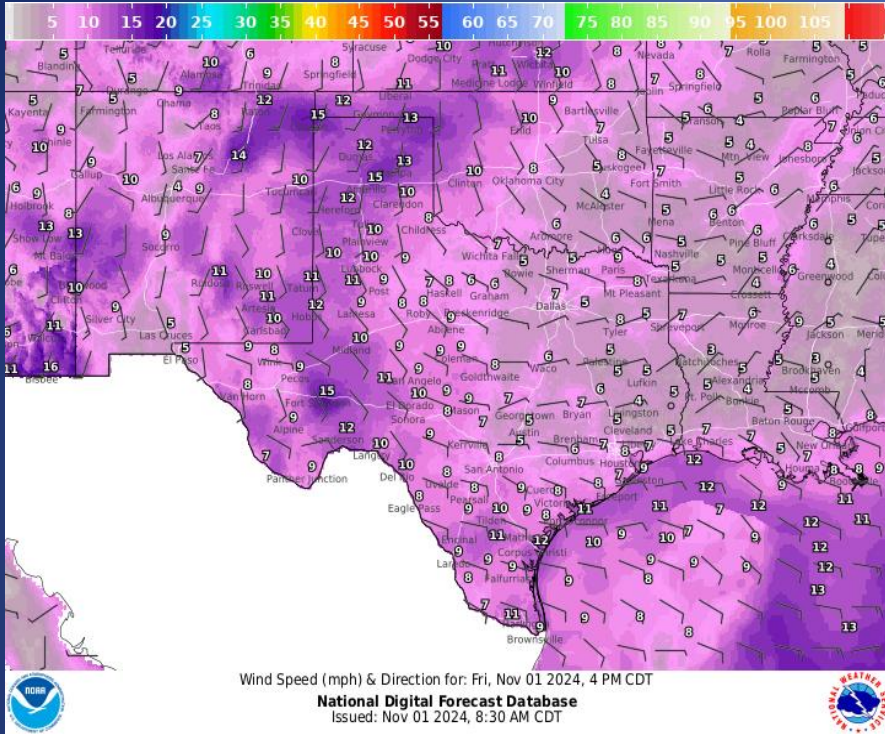

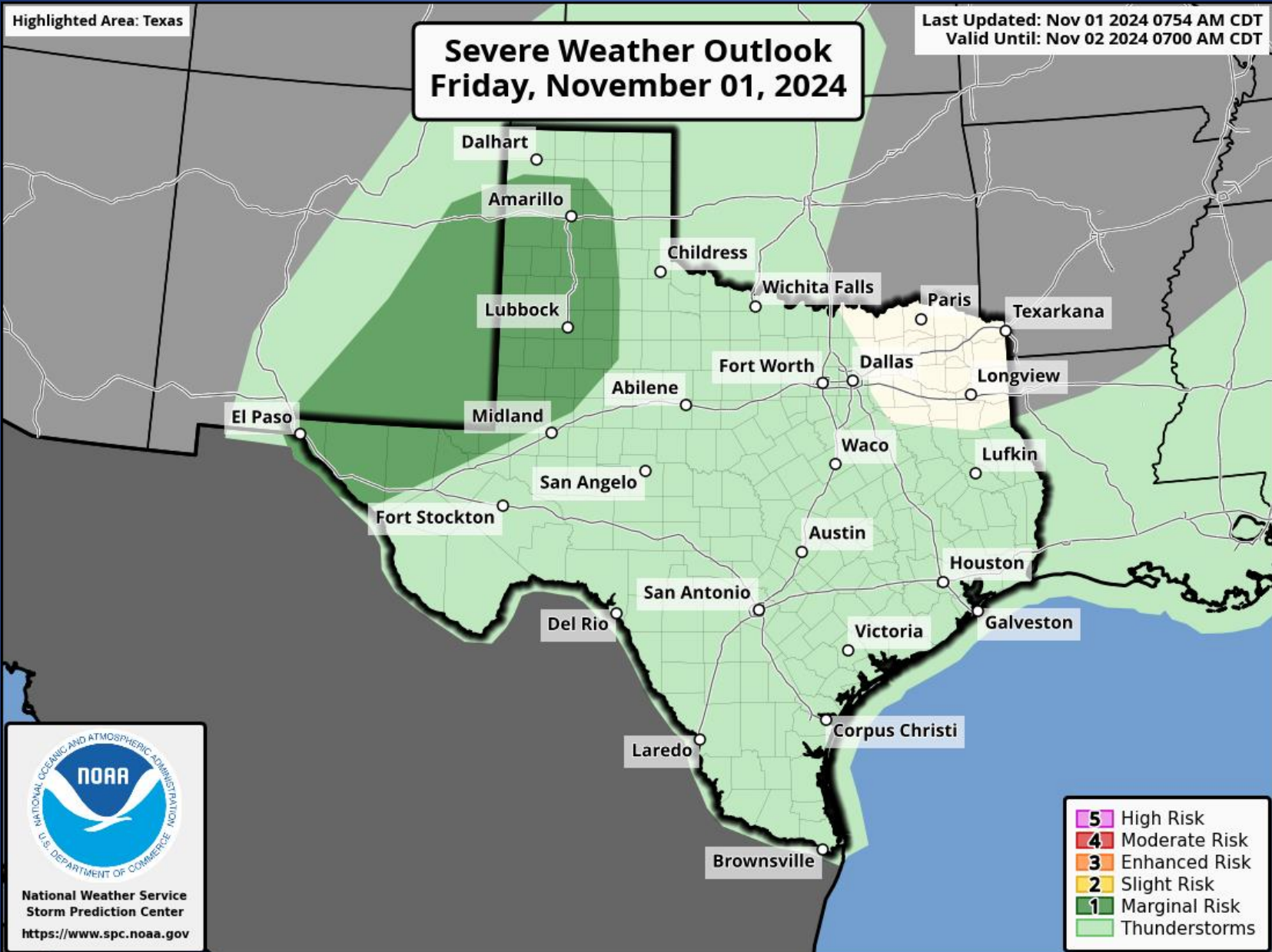

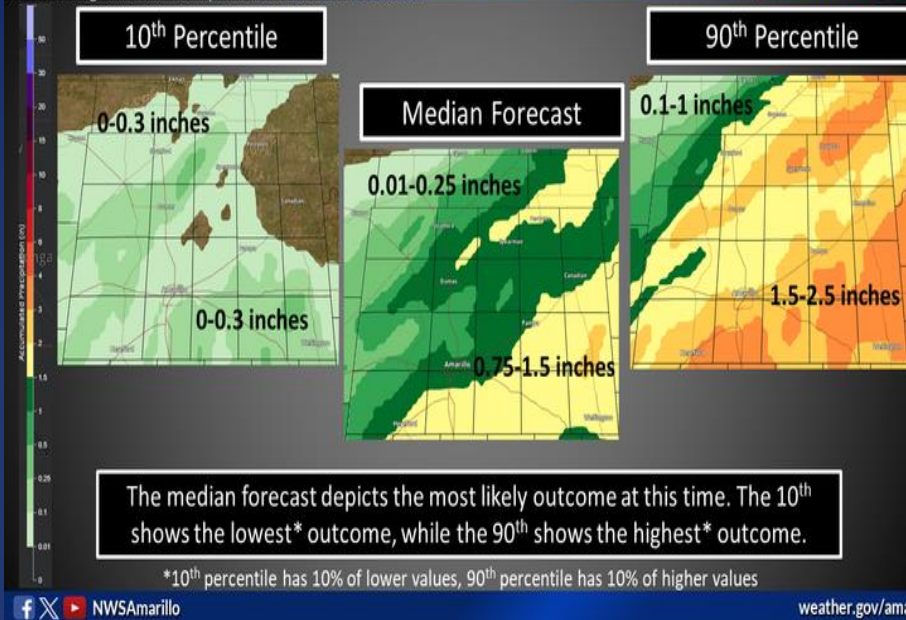

A wide range of values are possible for rain this weekend

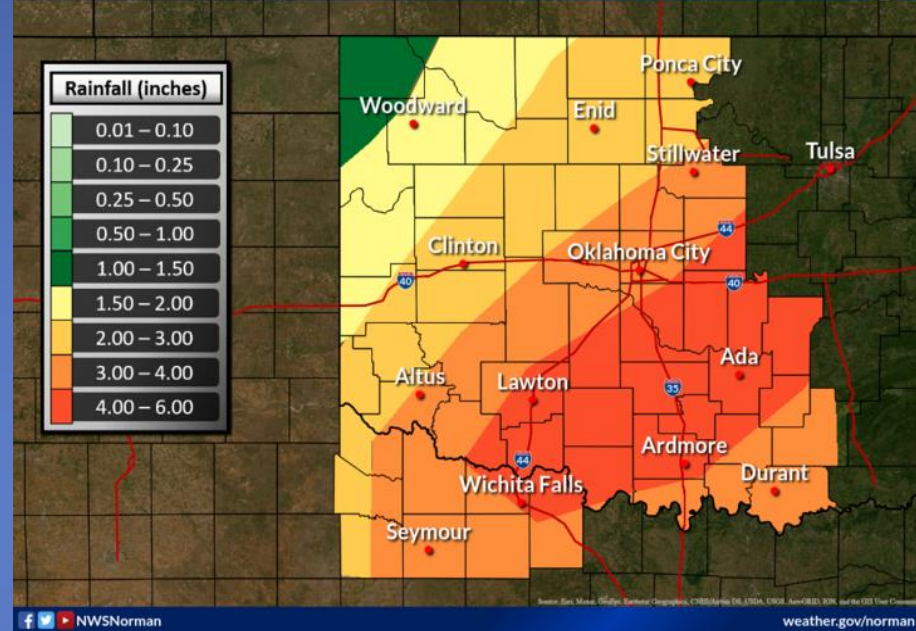


Potential Rainfall Amounts Through Monday

While rainfall has a high chance of occurring today there is still a large spread on possible rain amounts. This is mainly due to the showery nature of the rainfall where areas could see a lot of rain right next to a place that sees none. If the higher end of the rain occurs in an area then it could lead to flooding.

Get ready for multiple rounds of rain and thunderstorms beginning Friday night and ending Monday night. Locally heavier amounts of 5 to 8 inches are possible.

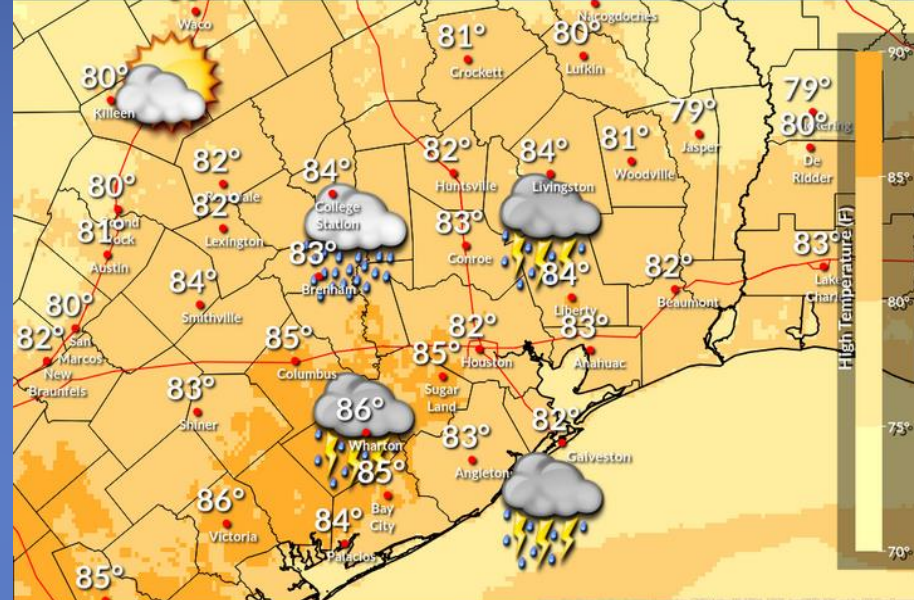

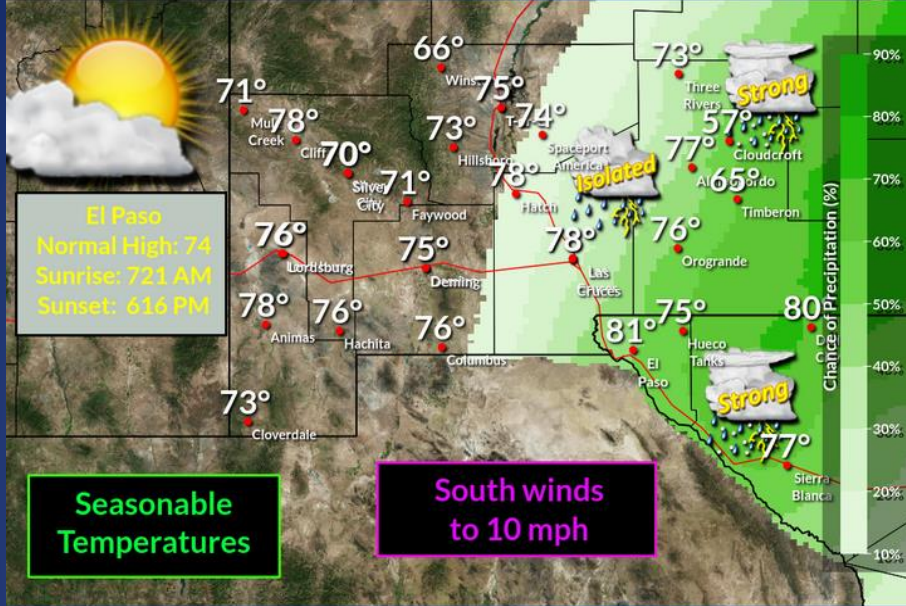

A dry-line will move in from the east Friday afternoon and evening. This will rapidly raise moisture in the east, mainly from El Paso east, and create isolated thunderstorms. A few thunderstorms could become strong with small hail and wind gusts to 50 mph. Temperatures will remain seasonable.

Severe thunderstorms are possible across much of the region late this afternoon into tonight. The strongest thunderstorms may produce torrential rainfall, large hail, and damaging winds. Have multiple ways to receive warnings this evening and tonight.

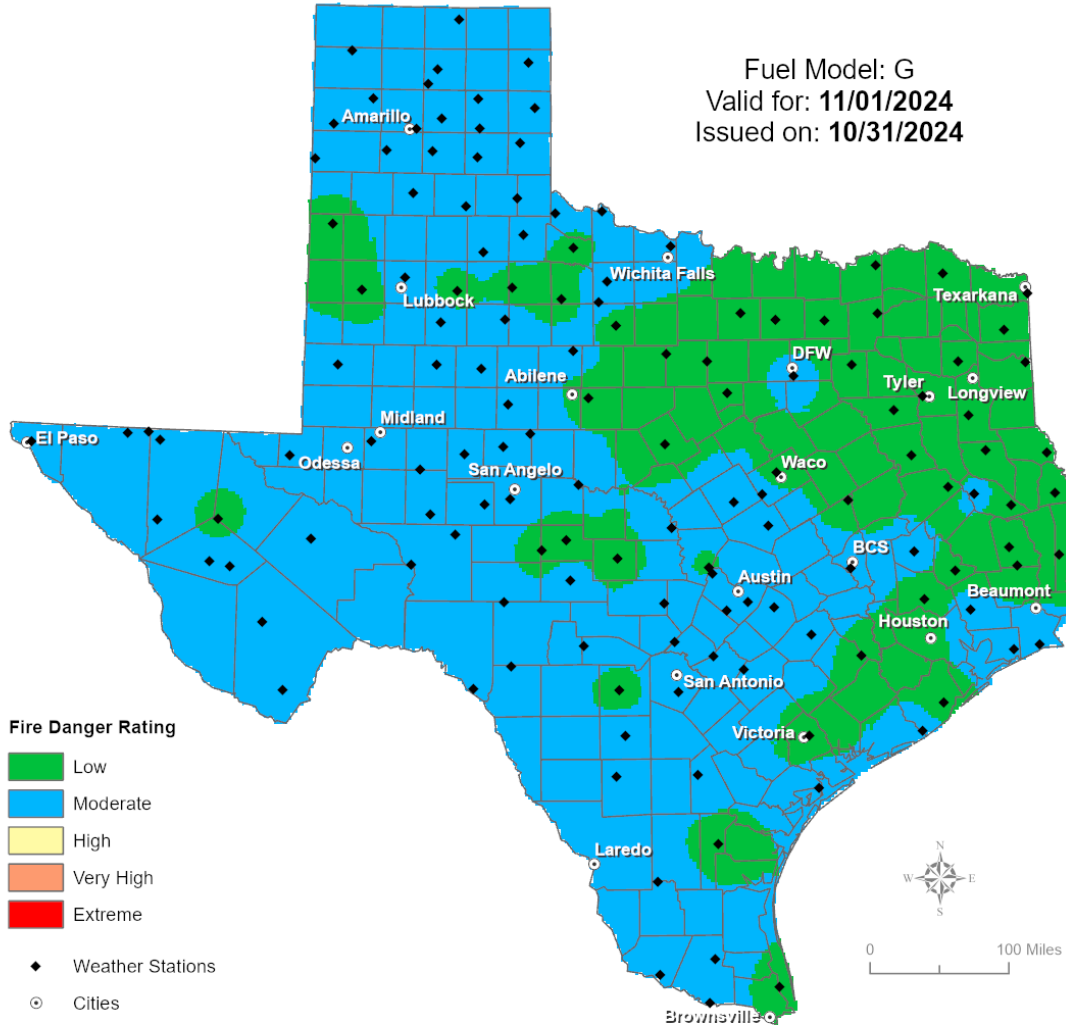

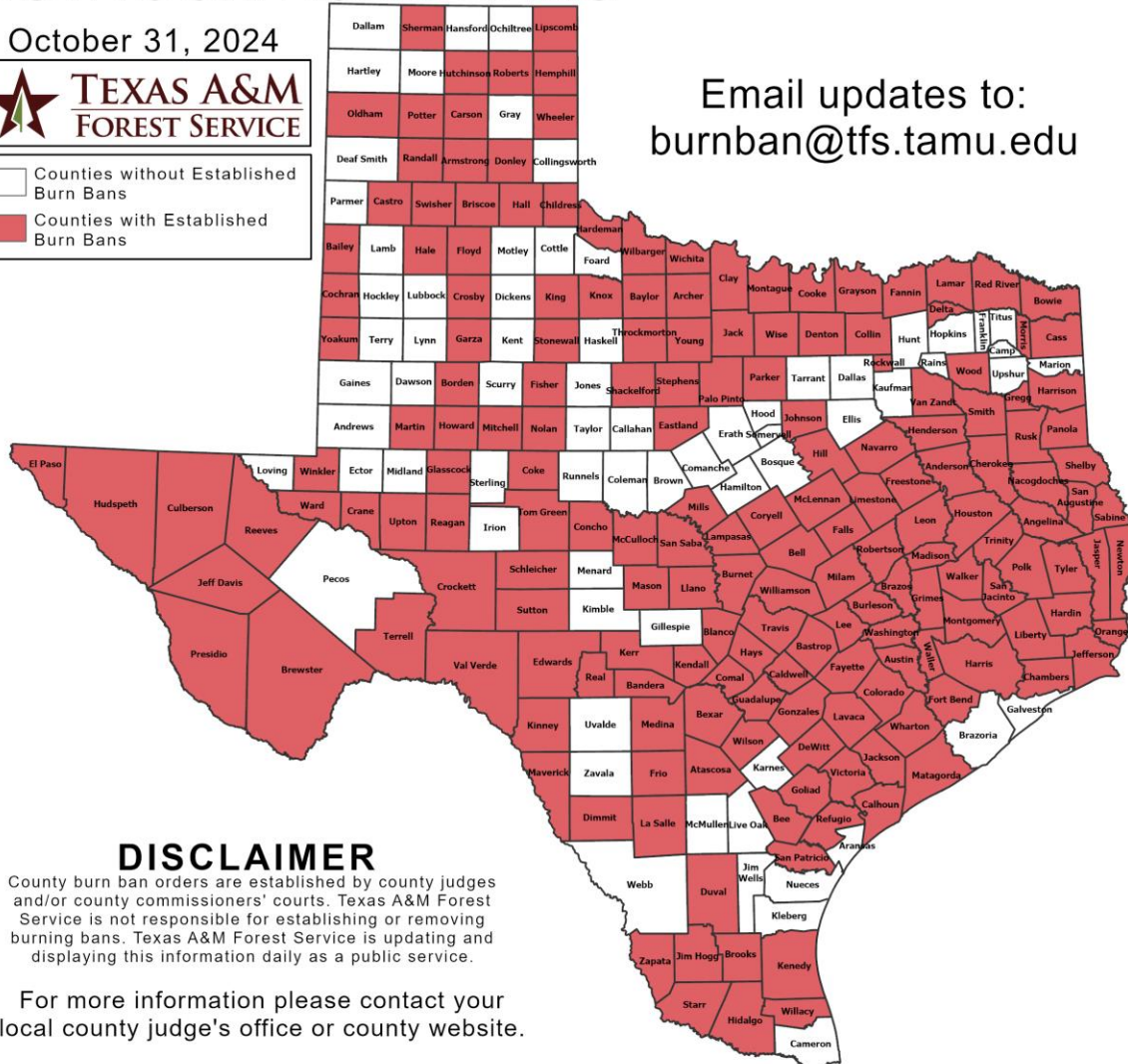

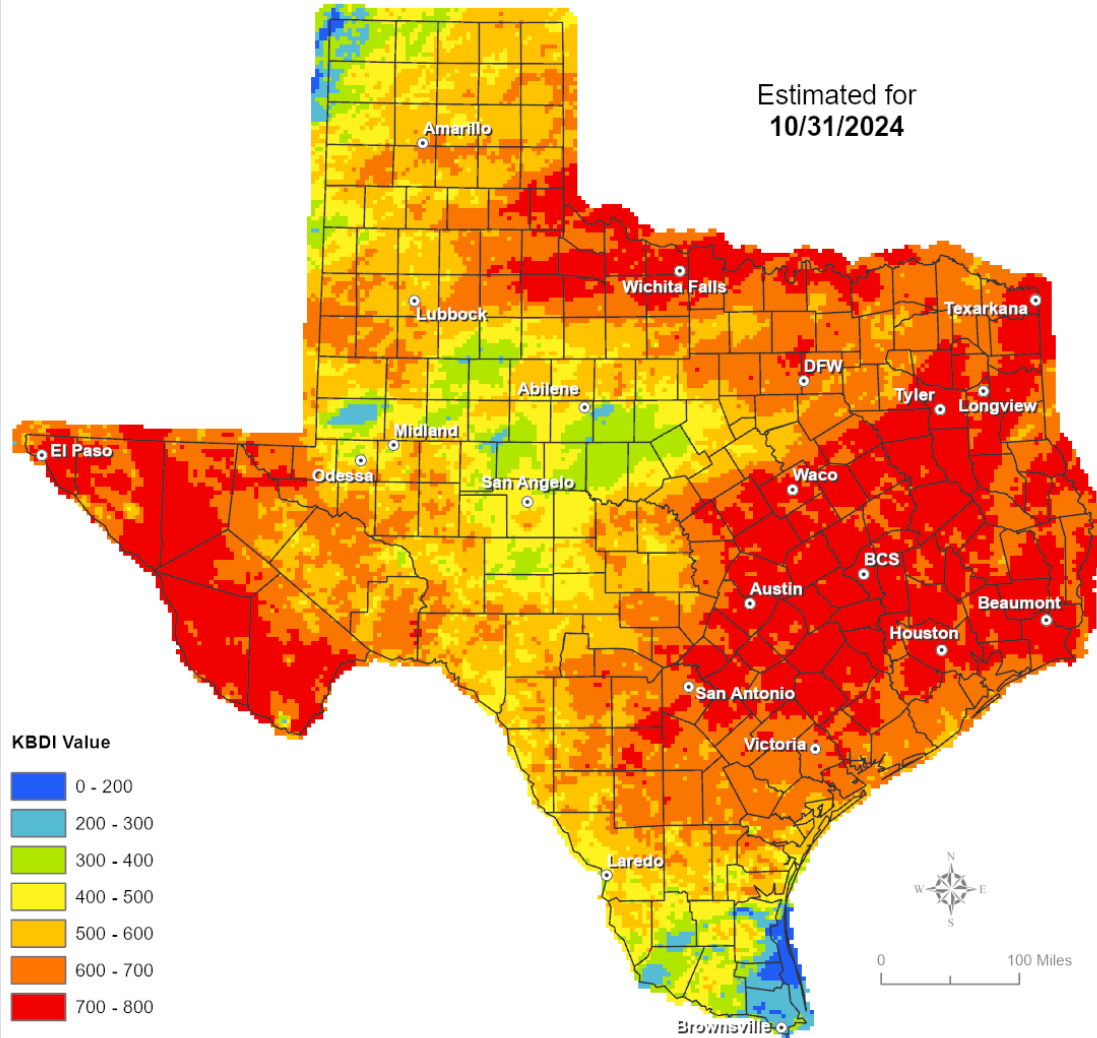

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

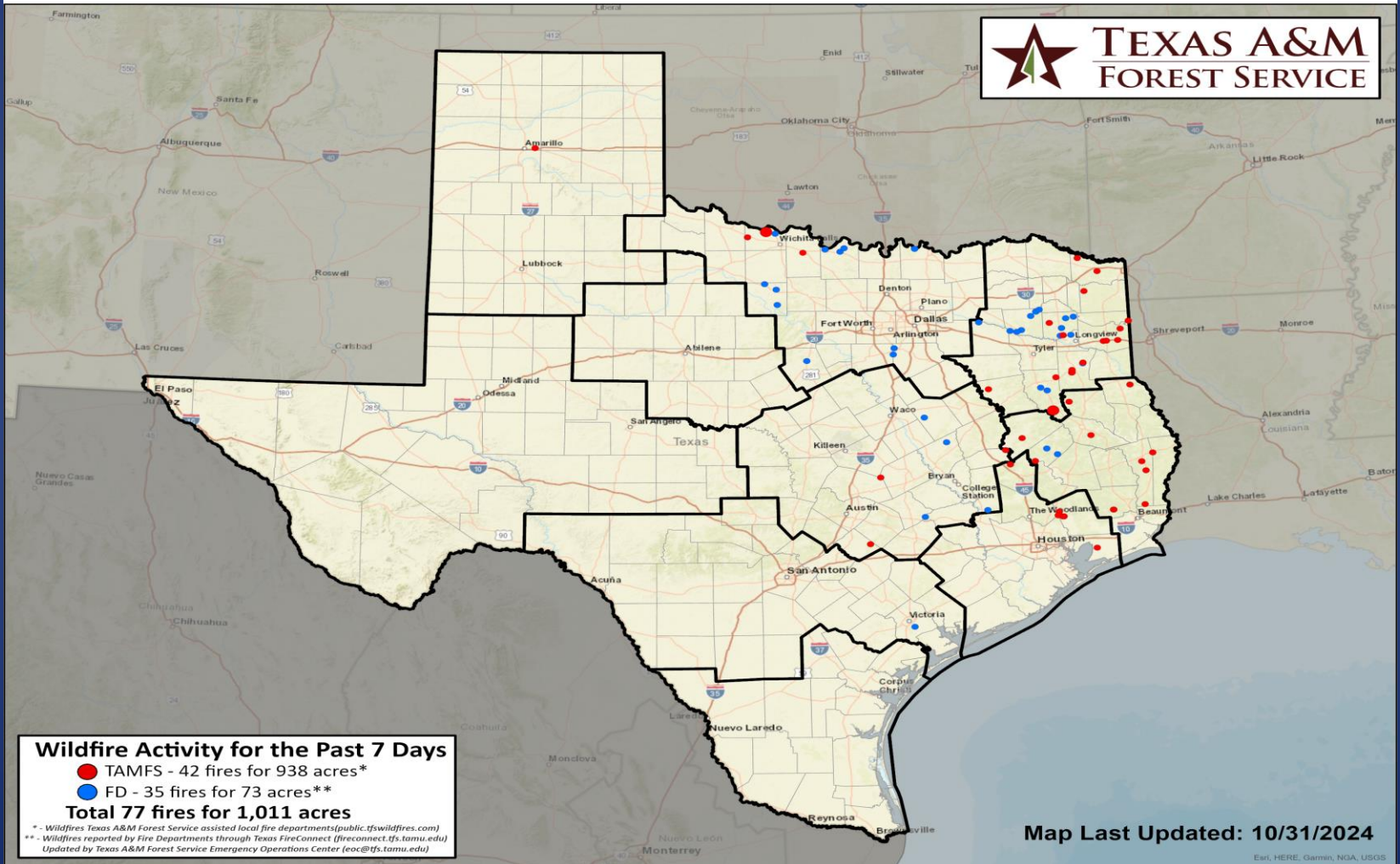
