A Pacific winter storm system swept across the area Thursday, leaving behind a chilly airmass. Hudspeth and far east El Paso Counties have not seen a freeze yet, but temperatures are finally expected to drop below freezing Saturday morning. Low temperatures are forecast to be from 28 to 32 degrees.



A Freeze Warning is in effect through early Saturday morning for the Davis Mountains and Foothills, Marfa Plateau, Van Horn and the Highway 54 Corridor, Reeves County, Eddy County Plains, and Northern and Central Lea County. 


