





# Keetch-Byram Drought Index



## Keetch-Byram Drought Index



# Fire Activity (\*Last 24 Hours)

Report of 573 (No Change) fires and 1,282,544 (No Change) acres have been burned this year. There are 118 (No Change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list contains 136 (No Change) counties with an average over 400.
